Get Set: Reestablish Values

- To "Get Set" is to be positioned in intense preparation mode poised for moving toward a goal or desired destination.
- Within the "getting set" moment, it can be highly advantageous to understand your core values; your core values provide an increase in focus and direction in the time of pre-action moments.
- To live a life governed by your values sets one up to receive optimum results.
- Is your life governed by what you value or by what arbitrarily happens?

Colossians 3:2-10 Amplified Bible

2 Set your mind and keep focused habitually on the things above [the heavenly things], not on things that are on the earth [which have only temporal value]. 3 For you died [to this world], and your [new, real] life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is our life, appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory. 5 So put to death and deprive of power the evil longings of your earthly body [with its sensual, self-centered instincts] immorality, impurity, sinful passion, evil desire, and greed, which is [a kind of] idolatry [because it replaces your devotion to God]. 6 Because of these [sinful] things the [divine] wrath of God is coming on the sons of disobedience [those who fail to listen and who routinely and obstinately disregard God's precepts], 7 and in these [sinful things] you also once walked, when you were habitually living in them [without the knowledge of Christ]. 8 But now rid yourselves [completely] of all these things: anger, rage, malice, slander, and obscene (abusive, filthy, vulgar) language from your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, for you have stripped off the old self with its evil practices, 10 and have put on the new [spiritual] self who is being continually renewed in true knowledge in the image of Him who created the new self—

Philippians 4:7-9 Expanded Bible

7 And God's peace, which is so great we cannot understand it [transcends/surpasses all comprehension], will keep [guard] your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. 8 [Finally; In conclusion; or Now then] Brothers and sisters, think about [focus your thoughts on; fill your minds with] things that are true and honorable and right [just] and pure and beautiful [lovely] and respected [commendable]. If there is anything that is good [morally excellent] and worthy of praise, think about [focus your thoughts on; fill your minds with] these things. 9 Do what you learned and received and heard from [in] me, and what you saw me do [in me]. And the God who gives [of] peace will be with you

WCC Values: Holy Spirit

Galatians 5:22-23 Amplified Bible

22 But the fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us] is **love** [unselfish concern for others], **joy**, [inner] **peace**, **patience** [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], **kindness**, **goodness**, **faithfulness**, 23 **gentleness**, **self-control**. Against such things there is no law.

But the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will help you remember everything that I have told you.
