Back to zero?

- > The fear of failing will turn your values into empty platitudes collecting dust in your soul
- Being governed by your values promotes focus for you, your angels and the enemy.
- Governing your life by what God and you value is an enemy to procrastination, non-fulfillment and depression.
- I just had a conversation with someone who is having to start something over. She's worried that it means going back to zero. Not true.
- When you start something new, you're not really beginning completely fresh. Your past experiences, failures, and successes have all taught you something. More than you realize. And knowing what you know now means you aren't starting over. You're just beginning again.
- Throughout my life I have learned the importance of purpose. Purpose is the why of my existence here on earth. It is the reason I get up in the morning. 2 Corinthians 5:17 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

17 Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!

Philippians 3:12-16 Amplified Bible (AMP)

12 Not that I have already obtained it [this goal of being Christlike] or have already been made perfect, but I actively press on so that I may take hold of that [perfection] for which Christ Jesus took hold of me and made me His own. 13 Brothers and sisters, I do not consider that I have made it my own yet; but one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and reaching forward to what lies ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the [heavenly] prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. 15 All of us who are mature [pursuing spiritual perfection] should have this attitude. And if in any respect you have a different attitude, that too God will make clear to you. 16 Only let us stay true to what we have already attained.
