Nehemiah 1 Amplified Bible (AMP)

1 The words of Nehemiah son of Hacaliah: Now it happened in the month of Chisley, in the twentieth year [of the Persian king], as I was in the capitol of Susa, 2 Hanani, one of my brothers, and some men from Judah came; and I asked them about the surviving Jews who had escaped and survived the captivity, and about Jerusalem. 3 They said to me, "The remnant there in the province who survived the captivity are in great distress and reproach; the wall of Jerusalem is broken down and its [fortified] gates have been burned (destroyed) by fire." 4 Now it came about when I heard these words. I sat down and wept and mourned for days; and I was fasting and praying [constantly] before the God of heaven. 5 And I said, "Please, O Lord God of heaven, the great and awesome God, who keeps the covenant and lovingkindness for those who love Him and keep His commandments, 6 please let Your ear be attentive and Your eyes open to hear the prayer of Your servant which I am praying before You, day and night, on behalf of Your servants, the sons (descendants) of Israel (Jacob), confessing the sins of the sons of Israel which we have committed against You; I and my father's house have sinned. 7 We have acted very corruptly against You and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the ordinances which You commanded Your servant Moses. 8 Please remember the word which You commanded Your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful and violate your obligations to Me I will scatter you [abroad] among the peoples; 9 but if you return to Me and keep My commandments and do them, though those of you who have been scattered are in the most remote part of the heavens, I will gather them from there and will bring them to the place where I have chosen for My Name to dwell.' 10 Now they are Your servants and Your people whom You have redeemed by Your great power and by Your strong hand. 11 Please, O Lord, let Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant and the prayer of Your servants who delight to [reverently] fear Your Name [Your essence, Your nature, Your attributes, with awel; and make Your servant successful this day and grant him compassion in the sight of this man [the king]." For I was cupbearer to the king [of Persia].

Prepare to Build Again because the fire is coming

1 Corinthians 3:9-17 Contemporary English Version (CEV)

9 Apollos and I work together for God, and you are God's garden and God's building. 10 God was kind and let me become an expert builder. I laid a foundation on which others have built. But we must each be careful how we build, 11 because Christ is the only foundation. 12-13 Whatever we

build on that foundation will be tested by fire on the day of judgment. Then everyone will find out if we have used gold, silver, and precious stones, or wood, hay, and straw. 14 We will be rewarded if our building is left standing. 15 But if it is destroyed by the fire, we will lose everything. Yet we ourselves will be saved, like someone escaping from flames. 16 All of you surely know that you are God's temple and that his Spirit lives in you. 17 Together you are God's holy temple, and God will destroy anyone who destroys his temple.

It can be extremely challenging to get your soul (mind, will, emotions) around building again

Nehemiah 2:17 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Then I said to them, "You see the bad situation that we are in—how Jerusalem is desolate and lies in ruins and its gates have been burned with fire.

- Recognize and Repent of your sin
- Return back to do the work
- Remember God

What does it take to build again

- > Zeal fervor for a person, cause, or object; eager desire or endeavor; enthusiastic diligence; ardor.
- Passion any powerful or compelling emotion or feeling, as love or hate.
- Vision an experience in which a personage, thing, or event appears vividly or credibly to the mind, although not actually present, often under the influence of a divine or other agency:
- Calling a strong impulse or inclination: Divine summons, vocation, or invitation.

Nehemiah 2:11-12 Amplified Bible (AMP)

11 So I came to Jerusalem and was there for three days. 12 Then I got up in the night, I and a few men with me. I did not tell anyone what my God was putting in my heart to do for Jerusalem,

When you get serious about building again you will have detractors

Nehemiah 2:19-20 Amplified Bible (AMP)

19 But when Sanballat the Horonite and Tobiah the Ammonite official and Geshem the Arab heard about it, they mocked us and regarded us with contempt and said, "What is this thing you are doing? Are you rebelling against the king?" 20 I answered them, "The God of heaven [has appointed us for His purpose and] will give us success; therefore we His servants will arise and build, but you have no portion, right, or memorial in Jerusalem."

Nehemiah 4:1-3 Amplified Bible (AMP)

1 But when Sanballat heard that we were rebuilding the wall, he became furious, completely

enraged, and he ridiculed the Jews. 2 He spoke before his brothers and the army of Samaria, "What are these feeble Jews doing? Can they restore it for themselves? Can they offer sacrifices? Can they finish in a day? Can they revive the stones from the heaps of dust and rubbish, even the ones that have been burned?" 3 Now Tobiah the Ammonite was beside him, and he said, "Even what they are building—if a fox should get up on it, he would break down their stone wall."

A lot of people choose not to build again

Luke 18:18-24 Amplified Bible (AMP)

18 A certain ruler asked Him, "Good Teacher [You who are essentially and morally good], what shall I do to inherit eternal life [that is, eternal salvation in the Messiah's kingdom]?" 19 Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is [essentially and morally] good except God alone. 20 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery, Do not murder, Do not steal, Do not testify falsely, Honor your father and your mother." 21 He replied, "I have kept all these things from my youth." 22 When Jesus heard this, He said to him, "You still lack one thing; sell everything that you have and distribute the money to the poor, and you will have [abundant] treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me [becoming My disciple, believing and trusting in Me and walking the same path of life that I walk]." 23 But when he heard these things, he became very sad, for he was extremely rich. 24 Jesus looked at him and said, "How difficult it is for those who are wealthy to enter the kingdom of God!

Finances or Faith

Count up the cost

Luke 14:28-32 Amplified Bible (AMP)

28 For which one of you, when he wants to build a watchtower [for his guards], does not first sit down and calculate the cost, to see if he has enough to finish it? 29 Otherwise, when he has laid a foundation and is unable to finish [the building], all who see it will begin to ridicule him, 30 saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish!' 31 Or what king, when he sets out to meet another king in battle, will not first sit down and consider whether he is strong enough with ten thousand men to encounter the one who is coming against him with twenty thousand? 32 Or else [if he feels he is not powerful enough], while the other [king] is still a far distance away, he sends an envoy and asks for terms of peace.

Nehemiah 2:17-18 Amplified Bible (AMP)

17 Then I said to them, "You see the bad situation that we are in—how Jerusalem is desolate and lies in ruins and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, and let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, so that we will no longer be a disgrace." 18 Then I told them how the hand of my God had been favorable to me and also about the words that the king had spoken to me. And they said, "Let us rise up and build." So they thoroughly supported the good work.

Love others as you Love yourself

Care about you and others

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Amplified Bible (AMP)

Therefore encourage and comfort one another and build up one another, just as you are doing.

Romans 14:19 Amplified Bible (AMP)

So then, let us pursue [with enthusiasm] the things which make for peace and the building up of one another [things which lead to spiritual growth].

Jude 20 Amplified Bible (AMP)

But you, beloved, build yourselves up on [the foundation of] your most holy faith [continually progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], pray in the Holy Spirit,
