Don't Forget! Remember God!

Sermon Notes from April 12, 2020

1 Corinthians 11:23-28 The Message (MSG)

23-26 Let me go over with you again exactly what goes on in the Lord's Supper and why it is so centrally important. I received my instructions from the Master himself and passed them on to you. The Master, Jesus, on the night of his betrayal, took bread. Having given thanks, he broke it and said, This is my body, broken for you. Do this to remember me. After supper, he did the same thing with the cup: This cup is my blood, my new covenant with you. Each time you drink this cup, remember me. What you must solemnly realize is that every time you eat this bread and every time you drink this cup, you reenact in your words and actions the death of the Master. You will be drawn back to this meal again and again until the Master returns. You must never let familiarity breed contempt. 27-28 Anyone who eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Master irreverently is like part of the crowd that jeered and spit on him at his death. Is that the kind of "remembrance" you want to be part of? Examine your motives, test your heart, come to this meal in holy awe.

Don't Forget God!

Proverbs 4:5 Amplified Bible (AMP)

5 "Get [skillful and godly] wisdom! Acquire understanding [actively seek spiritual discernment, mature comprehension, and logical interpretation]! **Do not forget nor turn away from the words of my mouth.**

Proverbs 3:1-6 Living Bible (TLB)

1-2 My son, **never forget the things I've taught you.** If you want a long and satisfying life, closely follow my instructions. 3 Never tire of loyalty and kindness. Hold these virtues tightly. Write them deep within your heart. 4-5 If you want favor with both God and man, and a reputation for good judgment and common sense, then trust the Lord completely; don't ever trust yourself. 6 In everything you do, put God first, and he will direct you and crown your efforts with success.

Psalm 78:5-8 Easy-to-Read Version (ERV)

5 He made an agreement with Jacob. He gave the law to Israel. He gave the commands to our ancestors. He told them to teach the law to their children. 6 Then the next generation, even the children not yet born, would learn the law. And they would be able to teach it to their own children.

7 So they would all trust in God, **never forgetting what he had done** and always obeying his commands. 8 They would not be like their ancestors, who were stubborn and refused to obey. Their hearts were not devoted to God, and they were not faithful to him.

The Word of God is an injection of Faith designed to kill the disease of doubt, division, destruction, worry and confusion!

What happens when you don't remember?

- > It breeds frustration causing one to rely on self instead of God.
- > Your thought process (decision-making) leans toward natural resolutions closing off the reality of super-natural resolutions.
- > It forces a repeat of important events or lessons not retained.

What happens when you remember God?

- Your steps are ordered by God resulting in total success and fulfillment
- You are able to walk by faith and not by sight
- You get to enjoy the promise of the fruit of the Spirit...Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self Control

Remember God!

Joshua 1:8 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

8 This Book of the Law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe and do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall deal wisely and have good success.

Hebrews 6:12 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

12 In order that you may not grow disinterested and become [spiritual] sluggards, **but imitators**, **behaving as do those who through faith (by their leaning of the entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness) and by practice of patient endurance and waiting are [now] inheriting the promises.**
