The Lord is my Shepherd

Psalm 23 Living Bible (TLB)

1 Because the Lord is my Shepherd, I have everything I need! 2-3 He lets me rest in the meadow grass and leads me beside the quiet streams. He gives me new strength. He helps me do what honors him the most. 4 Even when walking through the dark valley of death I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me, guarding, guiding all the way. 5 You provide delicious food for me in the presence of my enemies. You have welcomed me as your guest; blessings overflow! 6 Your goodness and unfailing kindness shall be with me all of my life, and afterwards I will live with you forever in your home.

1 John 4:18 Contemporary English Version (CEV)

18 **A real love for others will chase those worries away.** The thought of being punished is what makes us afraid. It shows that we have not really learned to love.

Psalm 23:1 New King James Version (NKJV)

1 The Lord is my Shepherd; I shall not want.

➤ Do what is possible before you consider trying to do what is impossible

We learn more about God and ourselves going through rather than going around

Psalm 23:4 Amplified Bible (AMP)

4 Even though I walk through the [sunless] valley of the shadow of death, I fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod [to protect] and Your staff [to guide], they comfort and console me.

John 10 New Living Translation (NLT)

10 “I tell you the truth, anyone who sneaks over the wall of a sheepfold, rather than going through the gate, must surely be a thief and a robber! 2 But the one who enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.

When your Shepherd is right then you can have faith for your destination to be right

3 John 2 Amplified Bible (AMP)

2 Beloved, I pray that in every way you may succeed and prosper and be in good health [physically], just as [I know] your soul prospers [spiritually].

Psalm 23:3 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

3 He refreshes and restores my soul (my life, my self); He leads me in the paths of righteousness [uprightness and right standing with Him—not for my earning it, but] for His name’s sake.

1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name’s sake. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever.
