Why is it difficult for people to change? It seems Impossible!

Matthew 19:26 Amplified Bible

26 But Jesus looked at them and said, "With people [as far as it depends on them] it is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

The impossible in your life has a purpose

Matthew 28:18-20 Amplified Bible

18 Jesus came up and said to them, "All authority (all power of absolute rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. 19 <u>Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations</u> [help the people to learn of Me, believe in Me, and obey My words], <u>baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you;</u> and lo, I am with you always [remaining with you perpetually—regardless of circumstance, and on every occasion], even to the end of the age."

It is to gauge the reception of your faith based on your understanding of what God has promised and what you are naturally experiencing or feeling.

John 11:14-15 The Message

14-15 Then Jesus became explicit: "Lazarus died. And I am glad for your sakes that I wasn't there. You're about to be given new grounds for believing. Now let's go to him."

Psalm 1:1-3 AMPC

1 Blessed (happy, fortunate, prosperous, and enviable) is the man who walks and lives not in the counsel of the ungodly [following their advice, their plans and purposes], nor stands [submissive and inactive] in the path where sinners walk, nor sits down [to relax and rest] where the scornful [and the mockers] gather. 2 But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law (the precepts, the instructions, the teachings of God) he habitually meditates (ponders and studies) by day and by night. 3 And he shall be like a tree firmly planted [and tended] by the streams of water, ready to bring forth its fruit in its season; its leaf also shall not fade or wither; and everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].
