### **Become more Intentional**

- **The way to start living now is to get more intentional about your life. If you were unconscious or lived a default life, you would continue to live the life that was there. You would allow anything to happen. You wouldn't make changes. You wouldn't get clear. You wouldn't be intentional. You wouldn't start, initiate, or improve. To get more intentional, you must choose. You must stand up for your preferences. You must say "no" to many things and "yes" to what you really want.**
