How do you know when you are dead in the Spirit?

- You lack revelation of God's Word from God or representatives of God. Matthew 13:10-15
- You think Spiritual matters are foolish. 1 Corinthians 2:14
- You are primarily led by your emotions.
- > You don't hunger and thirst after righteousness; until you require a miracle.

How do you know when you are dead in the flesh?

- > You make a choice to walk in the Spirit which starves and kills undesirable actions of the flesh. Galatians 5:16-26
- You deny your flesh. Luke 9:23
- You experience an unexplained freedom.
- You discover old desires have passed away and new desires refresh and produce newness within you. 2 Corinthians 5:14-19
- Your actions mirror God's instructions.

How do you know you are Alive in the flesh?

- You work hard to meet all of your desires instead of receiving His grace to change for His Glory.
- Your primary source of comfort comes from food, events, people, personal pursuits.
- > You rely on the whims of your gut rather than the Word of God leading you to the Spirit of God.
- > Review your Time Talent Treasure

How do you know you are Alive in the Spirit?

- > Holy Spirit is my primary teacher; not experience. John 14:26
- You meditate (seek, search, think, ponder) on His Word every day and night.
- You make decisions only based on His Word permeated and matured in your heart which produces prayer.
- > You understand by His Grace everything belongs to Him and you are a manager over it for the purpose of building His Kingdom on earth.
- > Your primary source of comfort/peace comes from The Spirit of God.
- You hunger and thirst after righteousness.

You are Alive in the Spirit

Galatians 5:22-25 Amplified Bible

22 But the fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us] is love [unselfish concern for others], joy, [inner] peace, patience [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such things there is no law. 24 And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature together with its passions and appetites. 25 If we [claim to] live by the [Holy] Spirit, we must also walk by the Spirit [with personal integrity, godly character, and moral courage—our conduct empowered by the Holy Spirit].
