We are partners with God

1 Corinthians 3:9 Amplified Bible

9 For we are God's fellow workers [His servants working together];

We are God's building

1 Corinthians 3:9 Amplified Bible

9 For **we are God's fellow workers** [His servants working together]; you are God's cultivated field [His garden, His vineyard], **God's building**.

I am the building - Jesus is the foundation

1 Corinthians 3:10-11 Amplified Bible

like a skillful master builder I laid a foundation, and now another is building on it. But each one must be careful how he builds on it, 11 for no one can lay a foundation other than the one which is [already] laid, which is Jesus Christ.

- FOUNDA'TION, noun [Latin fundatio, fundo.] 1. The basis of an edifice; that part of a building which lies on the ground; usually a wall of stone which supports the edifice. 2. The act of fixing the basis. 3. The basis or ground work, or any thing; that on which any thing stands, and by which it is supported. A free government has its foundation in the choice and consent of the people to be governed. Christ is the foundation of the church.

There will be an inspection so build with God's approved materials

1 Corinthians 3:9-15 The Message

9-15 Or, to put it another way, you are God's house. Using the gift God gave me as a good architect, I designed blueprints; Apollos is putting up the walls. Let each carpenter who comes on the job take care to build on the foundation! Remember, there is only one foundation, the one already laid: Jesus Christ. Take particular care in picking out your building materials. **Eventually there is going to be an inspection. If you use cheap or inferior materials, you'll be found out. The inspection will be thorough and rigorous.** You won't get by with a thing. If your work passes inspection, fine; if it doesn't, your part of the building will be torn out and started over. But you won't be torn out; you'll survive

 There will be an inspection, so build with God approved materials (love [unselfish concern for others], joy, [inner] peace, patience [not the ability to wait, but how we act while waiting], kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control) the fruit of the Spirit [the result of His presence within us]
