Giving Moments

2 Corinthians 8:1-5 Amplified Bible

1 Now, brothers and sisters, we want to tell you about the grace of God which has been evident in the churches of Macedonia [awakening in them a longing to contribute]; 2 for during an ordeal of severe distress, their abundant joy and their deep poverty [together] overflowed in the wealth of their lavish generosity. 3 For I testify that according to their ability, and beyond their ability, they gave voluntarily, 4 begging us insistently for the privilege of participating in the service for [the support of] the saints [in Jerusalem]. 5 Not only [did they give materially] as we had hoped, but first they gave themselves to the Lord and to us [as His representatives] by the will of God [disregarding their personal interests and giving as much as they possibly could].

Giving Moment

Psalm 37:5-9 Good News Translation

5 Give yourself to the Lord; trust in Him, and <u>he will help you</u>; 6 He will make your righteousness shine like the noonday sun. 7 <u>Be patient and wait for the Lord to act</u>; don't be worried about those who prosper or those who succeed in their evil plans. 8 <u>Don't give in to worry or anger</u>; <u>it only leads to trouble</u>. 9 Those who trust in the Lord will possess the land, but the wicked will be driven out.

Psalm 37:5-9 The Message

5-6 Open up before God, keep nothing back; He'll do whatever needs to be done: He'll validate your life in the clear light of day and stamp you with approval at high noon. 7 <u>Quiet down before God</u>, be prayerful before him. Don't bother with those who climb the ladder, who elbow their way to the top. 8-9 Bridle your anger, trash your wrath, cool your pipes—it only makes things worse. Before long the crooks will be bankrupt; God-investors will soon own the store.
