Giving Moments

- What is the greatest gift you have given?
- We asked God for salvation but many of us failed to give Him what was needed for an effective relationship in salvation...EVERYTHING!

Before you give anything else, consider first giving yourself completely to God

2 Corinthians 8:1-5 Amplified Bible

1 Now, brothers and sisters, we want to tell you about the grace of God which has been evident in the churches of Macedonia [awakening in them a longing to contribute]; 2 for during an ordeal of severe distress, their abundant joy and their deep poverty [together] overflowed in the wealth of their lavish generosity. 3 For I testify that according to their ability, and beyond their ability, they gave voluntarily, 4 begging us insistently for the privilege of participating in the service for [the support of] the saints [in Jerusalem]. 5 Not only [did they give materially] as we had hoped, but <u>first they gave themselves to the Lord</u> and to us [as His representatives] by the will of God [disregarding their personal interests and giving as much as they possibly could].

Giving Moment

James 4:6-8 Easy-to-Read Version

6 But the kindness God shows is greater. As the Scripture says, "God is against the proud, but he is kind to the humble." 7 So **give yourselves to God**. Stand against the devil, and he will run away from you. 8 <u>Come near to God and he will come near to you</u>. You are sinners, so clean sin out of your lives. <u>You are trying to follow God and the world at the same time. Make your thinking pure.</u>

James 4:6-8 Living Bible

6 But he gives us more and more strength to stand against all such evil longings. As the Scripture says, God gives strength to the humble but sets himself against the proud and haughty. 7 So **give yourselves humbly to God**. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 And when you draw close to God, God will draw close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and **let your hearts be filled with God alone** to make them pure and true to him.

• Be intentional about coming closer to God; also do an honest check on who and what you are following.

Psalm 37:5-9 Good News Translation

5 Give yourself to the Lord; trust in Him, and <u>he will help you</u>; 6 He will make your righteousness shine like the noonday sun. 7 <u>Be patient and wait for the Lord to act</u>; don't be worried about those who prosper or those who succeed in their evil plans. 8 <u>Don't give in to worry or anger</u>; <u>it only</u> <u>leads to trouble.</u> 9 Those who trust in the Lord will possess the land, but the wicked will be driven out.

Psalm 37:5-9 The Message

5-6 Open up before God, keep nothing back; He'll do whatever needs to be done: He'll validate your life in the clear light of day and stamp you with approval at high noon. 7 <u>Ouiet down before God</u>, be prayerful before him. Don't bother with those who climb the ladder, who elbow their way to the top. 8-9 Bridle your anger, trash your wrath, cool your pipes—it only makes things worse. Before long the crooks will be bankrupt; God-investors will soon own the store.
