Trust in The Word!

Proverbs 3:5 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

Lean on, **trust in, and be confident** in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding.

- > TRUST: reliance on the integrity, strength, ability, surety, etc., of a person or thing; confidence.
- > Confident expectation of something; hope.

Why don't we trust God's Word

- > Unwilling to receive His Love,... to believe His promises,...to think His Kingdom has anything to do with your situation.
- > Unable to have a personal experience with His Love,...to trust His promises,...to care about His Kingdom
- > Unaware of His Love,...His promises and His Kingdom

It's going to be a fight; Satan will try to get you down

Mark 3:27 Living Bible (TLB)

Satan must be bound before his demons are cast out, just as a strong man must be tied up before his house can be ransacked and his property robbed.

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 The Message (MSG)

7-10 Because of the extravagance of those revelations, and so I wouldn't get a big head, I was given the gift of a handicap to keep me in constant touch with my limitations. **Satan's angel did his best to get me down;** what he in fact did was push me to my knees. No danger then of walking around high and mighty! At first I didn't think of it as a gift, and begged God to remove it. Three times I did that, and then he told me, My grace is enough; it's all you need.

Pain, problems and persecution goes deep without asking...The Word of God needs your permission to go deep.

The enemy wants you to live off of what you know; God wants you to live off of what He knows. For some what is possible is based on what we understand; for others, what is possible is based on what God says

Matthew 13:19-23 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

19 While anyone is hearing the Word of the kingdom and does not grasp and comprehend it, **the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart.** This is what was sown along the roadside.20 As for what was sown on thin (rocky) soil, this is he who hears the Word and at once welcomes and accepts it with joy; 21 Yet it has no real root in him, but is temporary (inconstant, lasts but a little while); and when affliction or trouble or persecution comes on account of the Word, at once he is caused to stumble [he is repelled and begins to distrust and desert Him Whom he ought to trust and obey] and he falls away. 22 As for what was sown among thorns, this is he who hears the Word, but the cares of the world and the pleasure and delight and glamour and deceitfulness of riches choke and suffocate the Word, and it yields no fruit. 23 As for what was sown on good soil, this is he who hears the Word and grasps and comprehends it; he indeed bears fruit and yields in one case a hundred times as much as was sown, in another sixty times as much, and in another thirty.

Anytime a believer acts against the Word of God they impose a delay not denial on the reception of God's promises. This delay is for my favor!

2 Corinthians 1:20 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

For as many as are the promises of God, they all find their Yes [answer] in Him [Christ]. For this reason we also utter the Amen (so be it) to God through Him [in His Person and by His agency] to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 1:20 Amplified Bible (AMP)

For as many as are the promises of God, in Christ they are [all answered] "Yes." So through Him we say our "Amen" to the glory of God.

I'm learning how to trust God rather than try God!

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 The Message (MSG)

7-10 Because of the extravagance of those revelations, and so I wouldn't get a big head, I was given the gift of a handicap to keep me in constant touch with my limitations. Satan's angel did his best to get me down; what he in fact did was push me to my knees. No danger then of walking around high and mighty! At first I didn't think of it as a gift, and begged God to remove it. Three times I did that, and then he told me, My grace is enough; it's all you need. My strength comes into its own in your weakness. Once I heard that, I was glad to let it happen. I quit focusing on the handicap and began appreciating the gift. It was a case of Christ's strength moving in on my weakness. Now I take limitations in stride, and with good cheer, these limitations that cut me down to size—abuse, accidents, opposition, bad breaks. I just let Christ take over! And so the weaker I get, the stronger I become.

God will never let you down so don't walk away from His instructions!

1 Corinthians 10:13 The Message (MSG)

No test or temptation that comes your way is beyond the course of what others have had to face. All you need to remember is that God will never let you down; he'll never let you be pushed past your limit; he'll always be there to help you come through it.
