- natural ability to cope with everyday matters; common sense. Used in a sentence, "with mother wit you'll sidestep these hazards"
- Common sense (or simply sense) is sound, practical judgment concerning everyday matters, or a basic ability to perceive, understand, and judge in a manner that is shared by (i.e., "common to") nearly all people. A collective intelligence.

Common sense is not so common anymore

Proverbs 14:12-13 New Living Translation

12 **There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death.** 13 Laughter can conceal a heavy heart, but when the laughter ends, the grief remains.

Proverbs 14:12-13 The Message

12-13 **There's a way of life that looks harmless enough; look again**—it leads straight to hell. Sure, those people appear to be having a good time, but all that laughter will end in heartbreak.

The needle of common sense has definitely shifted from being biblically based to being secular based.

- The number of U.S. adults who read the Bible saw an "unprecedented drop" in early 2022, according
 to the State of the Bible 2022 report published by the American Bible Society on April 6.
- While 77% of U.S. adults have a Bible, the percentage of adults who are "Bible Users" people who
 read the Bible on their own outside of a church setting at least 3-4 times a year dropped 11
 percentage points to 39% in 2022.
- This represents a 25-million-person decline to 103 million Bible Users since last year. The needle of common sense has definitely shifted from being biblically based to being secular based.

The lack of God's Word causes social problems affecting our society

 Examples of social problems: Poverty, unemployment, unequal opportunity, racism, malnutrition, substandard housing, homelessness, employment discrimination, mass-murders, child abuse and neglect, crime and substance abuse, increased divisions.

Romans 1:28-31 Amplified Bible

28 And since they did not see fit to acknowledge God or consider Him worth knowing [as their Creator], God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do things which are improper and repulsive, 29 until they were filled (permeated, saturated) with every kind of unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice and mean-spiritedness. They are gossips [spreading rumors], 30 slanderers, haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors [of new forms] of evil, disobedient and disrespectful to parents, 31 without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful [without pity].

The needle of common sense has definitely shifted from being biblically based to being secular based.

- A survey from 2021 found that 11 percent of Americans read the Bible daily. Trends in reading habits
 over four years showed that the majority of Americans never read the Bible, however in 2021 this
 number dropped to 29 percent of respondents.
- Bible readership demographics: Bible readership varies across each demographic, with Millennials most likely to have never read the Bible, whereas the most frequent readers were those aged over 70 years old. Looking at the preferences of the older readers, traditional books were favored, with 91 percent opting for a print version of the Bible to read over other formats.
- Although figures show that fewer people are reading the Bible, there is still a genuine desire to read the Bible amongst the American population, with 56 percent of those asked in 2019 expressing a wish to read it. Changes in attitudes have not been drastic, but rather it seems that disengagement with the Christian scripture has been a gradual process.
