2017 Year of New Perspective

 Pastor Daren Barron regarding 2017: 2017 is the year of Increase and New Perspective (Seeing like God, Hearing like God, Speaking like God)

Colossians 3:1-2 (The Message, MSG)

1-2 So if you're serious about living this new resurrection life with Christ, act like it. Pursue the things over which Christ presides. Don't shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with the things right in front of you. Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that's where the action is. See things from his perspective.

Ephesians 4:11-12 (New Living Translation, NLT)

11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the **Pastors** and teachers. 12 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ.

Jeremiah 3:15 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

"Then [in the final time] I will give you [spiritual] shepherds after My own heart, who will feed you with knowledge and [true] understanding.

14 This was the third time Jesus had appeared to his disciples since he had been raised from the dead. 15 After breakfast Jesus asked Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" "Yes, Lord," Peter replied, "you know I love you." "Then feed my lambs," Jesus told him. 16 Jesus repeated the question: "Simon son of John, do you love me?" "Yes, Lord," Peter said, "you know I love you." "Then take care of my sheep," Jesus said. 17 A third time he asked him, "Simon son of John, do you love me? Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, "Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you." Jesus said, "Then feed my sheep.
