## **God's Perspective: Mission Minded – Part II**

Sermon Notes from April 9, 2017

**Jesus' mission was to set me free and Establish The Kingdom of God on Earth**

### **Isaiah 9:2-7 The Message (MSG)**

2-7 The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light. For those who lived in a land of deep shadows—light! sunbursts of light! You repopulated the nation, you expanded its joy. Oh, they're so glad in your presence! Festival joy! The joy of a great celebration, sharing rich gifts and warm greetings. The abuse of oppressors and cruelty of tyrants—all their whips and curses—Is gone, done away with, a deliverance as surprising and sudden as Gideon's old victory over Midian. The boots of all those invading troops, along with their shirts soaked with innocent blood, Will be piled in a heap and burned, a fire that will burn for days! **For a child has been born—for us! the gift of a son—for us! He'll take over the running of the world. His names will be: Amazing Counselor, Strong God, Eternal Father, Prince of Wholeness. His ruling authority will grow, and there'll be no limits to the wholeness he brings. He'll rule from the historic David throne over that promised kingdom. He'll put that kingdom on a firm footing and keep it going With fair dealing and right living, beginning now and lasting always.** The zeal of God-of-the-Angel-Armies will do all this.

### **Matthew 4:17 New Living Translation (NLT)**

From then on Jesus began to preach, "Repent of your sins and turn to God, for the Kingdom of Heaven is near."

### **Luke 19:10 New Living Translation (NLT)**

10 **For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost."**

### **Matthew 20:28 Amplified Bible (AMP)**

28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, **but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many [paying the price to set them free from the penalty of sin]."**

### **John 10:10 Amplified Bible (AMP)**

10 The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. **I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].**

### **Luke 4:18-19 Living Bible (TLB)**

18-19 “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me; he has appointed me to preach Good News to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted and to announce that captives shall be released and the blind shall see, that the downtrodden shall be freed from their oppressors, and that God is ready to give blessings to all who come to him.”

### **Luke 4:18-19 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)**

18 The Spirit of the Lord [is] upon Me, because He has anointed Me [the Anointed One, the Messiah] to preach the good news (the Gospel) to the poor; He has sent Me to announce release to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth as delivered those who are oppressed [who are downtrodden, bruised, crushed, and broken down by calamity], 19 To proclaim the accepted and acceptable year of the Lord [the day when salvation and the free favors of God profusely abound].

### **My Mission is...**

### **Matthew 28:18-20 Amplified Bible (AMP)**

18 **Jesus came up and said to them, “All authority (all power of absolute rule) in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.** 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations [help the people to learn of Me, believe in Me, and obey My words], baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe everything that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always [remaining with you perpetually—regardless of circumstance, and on every occasion], even to the end of the age.”

### **Mark 6:7-13 Amplified Bible (AMP)**

7 And He called the twelve [disciples] and began to send them out [as His special messengers] two by two, and gave them authority and power over the unclean spirits. 8 He told them to take nothing for the journey except a mere walking stick—no bread, no [traveler’s] bag, no money in their belts— 9 but to wear sandals; and [He told them] not to wear two tunics. 10 And He told them, “Wherever you go into a house, stay there until you leave that town. 11 Any place that does not welcome you or listen to you, when you leave there, shake the dust off the soles of your feet as a testimony against them [breaking all ties with them because they rejected My message].” 12 So they went out and preached that men should repent [that is, think differently, recognize sin, turn away from it, and live changed lives]. 13 And they were casting out many demons and were anointing with oil many who were sick, and healing them.

### **Luke 10:1-11 Living Bible (TLB)**

1 The Lord now chose seventy other disciples and sent them on ahead in pairs to all the towns and villages he planned to visit later. 2 These were his instructions to them: “Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out more laborers to help you, for the harvest is so plentiful and the workers so few. 3 Go now, and remember that I am sending you out as lambs among wolves. 4 Don’t take any money with you, or a beggar’s bag, or even an extra pair of shoes. And don’t waste time along the way. 5 “Whenever you enter a home, give it your blessing. 6 If it is worthy of the blessing, the blessing will stand; if not, the blessing will return to you. 7 “When you enter a village, don’t shift around from home to home, but stay in one place, eating and drinking without question whatever is set before you. And don’t hesitate to accept hospitality, for the workman is worthy of his wages! 8-9 “If a town welcomes you, follow these two rules: (1) Eat whatever is set before you. (2) Heal the sick; and as you heal them, say, ‘The Kingdom of God is very near you now.’ 10 “But if a town

refuses you, go out into its streets and say, 11 'We wipe the dust of your town from our feet as a public announcement of your doom. Never forget how close you were to the Kingdom of God!'

### **Matthew 28:18-20 The Message (MSG)**

18-20 Jesus, undeterred, went right ahead and gave his charge: **"God authorized and commanded me to commission you:** Go out and train everyone you meet, far and near, in this way of life, marking them by baptism in the threefold name: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Then instruct them in the practice of all I have commanded you. I'll be with you as you do this, day after day after day, right up to the end of the age."

### **Jesus' Mission Challenged**

#### **Luke 22:40-43 New Living Translation (NLT)**

40 There he told them, "Pray that you will not give in to temptation." 41 He walked away, about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, 42 "Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." 43 Then an angel from heaven appeared and strengthened him.

### **Your Mission will be challenged**

- **Commitment...The best way to distract a person with a goal is to give them another one**
- **Complaining...Losers discuss what they are going through, champions discuss what they are going to**
- **Convenient / Comfortable**
- **Confusion...1 Corinthians 14:33**
- **Conflict / Confrontation...You can never correct what you are unwilling to confront.**
- **Chastise...Hebrews 12:6-7**
- **Crisis...Crisis always occurs at the curve of change**

### **Your Mission will change you**

- **Character - what you are will outlast what people say you are**
- **Counseling - you are never responsible for the pain of those who have rejected your counsel.**
- **Confession - what you keep saying you eventually believe**
