Mothers give Everything

- **Provide protective covering for nine months**
- **Process of birth**
- **Change physically, mentally, socially, financially, relationally, spiritually**
- **Time, energy, focus, patience, hope, love**

Everything

Luke 5:27-32 (New Living Translation, NLT)

27 Later, as Jesus left the town, he saw a tax collector named Levi sitting at his tax collector's booth. "Follow me and be my disciple," Jesus said to him. 28 So **Levi got up, left everything, and followed him.** 29 Later, Levi held a banquet in his home with Jesus as the guest of honor. Many of Levi's fellow tax collectors and other guests also ate with them. 30 But the Pharisees and their teachers of religious law complained bitterly to Jesus' disciples, "Why do you eat and drink with such scum?" 31 Jesus answered them, "Healthy people don't need a doctor—sick people do. 32 I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners and need to repent."

This is called REAL Living

- **I know what it feels like to give up EVERYTHING physically.**
- **I know what it feels like to give up EVERYTHING mentally.**
- **I know what it feels like to give up EVERYTHING spiritually.**

Everything

- **There is a difference between giving up Everything and someone taking Everything; knowing who your source is makes all the difference!**

Mark 10:17-25 (NLT)

17 As Jesus was starting out on his way to Jerusalem, a man came running up to him, knelt down, and asked, “**Good Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?**” 18 “Why do you call me good?” Jesus asked. “Only God is truly good. 19 But to answer your question, you know the commandments: ‘You must not murder. You must not commit adultery. You must not steal. You must not testify falsely. You must not cheat anyone. Honor your father and mother.’” 20 “Teacher,” the man replied, “I’ve obeyed all these commandments since I was young.” 21 Looking at the man, Jesus felt genuine love for him. **“There is still one thing you haven’t done,” he told him. “Go and sell all your possessions and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me.”** 22 At this the man’s face fell, and he went away sad, for he had many possessions. 23 Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, “How hard it is for the rich to enter the Kingdom of God!” 24 This amazed them. But Jesus said again, “Dear children, it is very hard to enter the Kingdom of God. 25 In fact, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich person to enter the Kingdom of God!”

- **Worldly Comfort is an enemy of Giving; especially Giving EVERYTHING!**
- **The Comfort of the World will not yield you what you ask for...**

Everything You Need!

Matthew 19:27 (Living Bible, TLB)

Then Peter said to him, “We left everything to follow you. **What will we get out of it?**”

When a Mother gives Everything

Exodus 2:1-10 (New International Version, NIV)

1 Now a man of the tribe of Levi married a Levite woman, 2 and **she became pregnant and gave birth to a son. When she saw that he was a fine child, she hid him for three months. 3 But when she could hide him no longer, she got a papyrus basket for him and coated it with tar and pitch. Then she placed the child in it and put it among the reeds along the bank of the Nile.** 4 His sister stood at a distance to see what would happen to him. 5 Then Pharaoh’s daughter went down to the Nile to bathe, and her attendants were walking along the riverbank. She saw the basket among the reeds and sent her female slave to get it. 6 She opened it and saw the baby. He was crying, and she felt sorry for him. “This is one of the Hebrew babies,” she said. 7 Then his sister asked Pharaoh’s daughter, “Shall I go and get one of the Hebrew women to nurse the baby for you?” 8 “Yes, go,” she answered. So the girl went and got the baby’s mother. 9 Pharaoh’s daughter said to her, “Take this baby and nurse him for me, and I will pay you.” So the woman took the baby and nursed him. 10 When the child grew older, she took him to Pharaoh’s daughter and he became her son. She named him Moses, saying, “I drew him out of the water.”

Everything

- **Have you given up everything you have; or have you given up everything God has given you?**

1 John 4:13 (NLT)

And God has given us his Spirit as proof that we live in him and he in us.

1 John 4:4 (NLT)

But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world.

Everything

- **With EVERYTHING you gain you give up something; With EVERYTHING you give up you gain something else.**
- **Everything you want in your future exists in your possession as a seed.**
- **When you are able to give up Everything you currently have... you position yourself to receive Everything you want that you don't have.**

When a Mother gives Everything

1 Samuel 1:19-28 (TLB)

19-20 The entire family was up early the next morning and went to the Tabernacle to worship the Lord once more. Then they returned home to Ramah, and when Elkanah slept with Hannah, the Lord remembered her petition; in the process of time, a baby boy was born to her. She named him Samuel (meaning "asked of God") because, as she said, "I asked the Lord for him." 21-22 The next year Elkanah and Peninnah and her children went on the annual trip to the Tabernacle without Hannah, for she told her husband, "Wait until the baby is weaned, and then I will take him to the Tabernacle and leave him there." 23 "Well, whatever you think best," Elkanah agreed. "May the Lord's will be done." So she stayed home until the baby was weaned. 24 Then, though he was still so small, they took him to the Tabernacle in Shiloh, along with a three-year-old bull for the sacrifice, and a bushel of flour and some wine. 25 After the sacrifice they took the child to Eli. 26 **"Sir, do you remember me?" Hannah asked him. "I am the woman who stood here that time praying to the Lord! 27 I asked him to give me this child, and he has given me my request; 28 and now I am giving him to the Lord for as long as he lives."** So she left him there at the Tabernacle for the Lord to use.

Mothers keep on giving EVERYTHING to God

Romans 12:1-2 (The Message, MSG)

1-2 **So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life—and place it before God as an offering.** Embracing what God does for you is the best thing you can do for him. Don't become so

well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out. Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you.
