### God has given us EveryThing we need

#### 2 Peter 1:2-4 (New Living Translation, NLT)

2 May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord. 3 **By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him,** the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. 4 And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.

### EVERYTHING

- **God has already given us EVERYTHING we need. It is up to us to receive what has been given to us through Grace by Faith.**
- **Because God has given us EVERYTHING, the devil deceives us and makes us believe we have Somethings or Nothing.**
- **If the enemy steals my ability to believe God, I won't know I have EveryThing in Him; so I will look for what I need elsewhere.**

**If the enemy steals my Faith he takes away my ability to function properly in the earth realm**

#### John 10:10 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

10 **The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy.** I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

## How did we let him steal EVERYTHING

- **We allow the World systems (the devil) to create a personal brand of religion that fits with the life want to live.**
- **We allowed the enemy to make us think our sin has no consequence.**
- **We were deceived to think our sin is greater than what Christ did on the cross (paid for all of our sins).**

## the devil is a deceiver; but I caught him!

### 2 Corinthians 11:14-15 (NLT)

14 But I am not surprised! **Even Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.** 15 So it is no wonder that his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness. In the end they will get the punishment their wicked deeds deserve.

### Ephesians 6:11 (AMP)

11 Put on the full armor of God [for His precepts are like the splendid armor of a heavily-armed soldier], so that you may be able to [successfully] **stand up against all the schemes and the strategies and the deceits of the devil.**

### Revelation 12:9 (AMP)

9 And the great dragon was thrown down, **the age-old serpent who is called the devil and Satan, he who continually deceives and seduces the entire inhabited world;** he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.

## the devil is a deceiver; but I caught him! he owes me!

### Proverbs 6:30-31 (English Standard Version, ESV)

30 People do not despise a thief if he steals to satisfy his appetite when he is hungry, 31 **but if he is caught, he will pay sevenfold;** he will give all the goods of his house.

## EVERYTHING

### Mark 3:27 (Living Bible, TLB)

27 Satan must be bound before his demons are cast out, just as a strong man must be tied up before his house can be ransacked and his property robbed.

## Give God what He gave to you...EVERYTHING

### James 4:7-10 (The Message, MSG)

7-10 So let God work his will in you. Yell a loud no to the Devil and watch him scamper. Say a quiet yes to God and he'll be there in no time. Quit dabbling in sin. Purify your inner life. Quit playing the field. Hit bottom, and cry your eyes out. The fun and games are over. Get serious, really serious. Get down on your knees before the Master; it's the only way you'll get on your feet.

## **EVERYTHING**

### **2 Corinthians 12:7-10 (MSG)**

7-10 Because of the extravagance of those revelations, and so I wouldn't get a big head, I was given the gift of a handicap to keep me in constant touch with my limitations. Satan's angel did his best to get me down; what he in fact did was push me to my knees. No danger then of walking around high and mighty! At first I didn't think of it as a gift, and begged God to remove it. Three times I did that, and then he told me, My grace is enough; it's all you need. My strength comes into its own in your weakness. Once I heard that, I was glad to let it happen. I quit focusing on the handicap and began appreciating the gift. It was a case of Christ's strength moving in on my weakness. Now I take limitations in stride, and with good cheer, these limitations that cut me down to size—abuse, accidents, opposition, bad breaks. I just let Christ take over! And so the weaker I get, the stronger I become.
