God has given us Everything we need

2 Peter 1:2-4 (New Living Translation, NLT)

2 May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord. 3 By his divine power, **God has given us everything we need for living a godly life.** We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. 4 And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.

God wants everything we have, everything we are

Deuteronomy 6:5 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and mind and with all your soul and with all your strength [your entire being].

Luke 10:25-28 (AMP)

25 And a certain lawyer [an expert in Mosaic Law] stood up to test Him, saying, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" 26 Jesus said to him, "What is written in the Law? How do you read it?" 27 And he replied, "**You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself.**" 28 Jesus said to him, "You have answered correctly; do this habitually and you will live."

God wants to exchange what we have and who we are for what He has and who He is

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 (AMP)

9 but just as it is written [in Scripture], "Things which the eye has not seen and the ear has not heard, And which have not entered the heart of man, All that God has prepared for those who love Him [who hold Him in affectionate reverence, who obey Him, and who gratefully recognize the

benefits that He has bestowed].” 10 For God has unveiled them and revealed them to us through the [Holy] Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things [diligently], even [sounding and measuring] the [profound] depths of God [the divine counsels and things far beyond human understanding].

We don't experience everything from God because we have not given everything to God.

Galatians 6:7-9 (New King James Version, NKJV)

7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. 8 For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life. 9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

Matthew 16:25 (Living Bible, TLB)

For anyone who keeps his life for himself shall lose it; and anyone who loses his life for me shall find it again.

The difference between wants and needs

➤ If I have everything...why is it I don't have everything I want?

Why do your desires go unfulfilled?

James 4:2-3 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition (AMPC)

2 You are jealous and covet [what others have] and **your desires go unfulfilled**; [so] you become murderers. [To hate is to murder as far as your hearts are concerned.] You burn with envy and anger and are not able to obtain [the gratification, the contentment, and the happiness that you seek], so you fight and war. **You do not have, because you do not ask.** 3 [Or] **you do ask [God for them] and yet fail to receive, because you ask with wrong purpose** and evil, selfish motives. Your intention is [when you get what you desire] to spend it in sensual pleasures.

Why don't you have everything you want?

- **You didn't ask**
- **Wrong purpose/desires**
- **Faith**
- **Prayer/fasting**
- **God is still teaching you...(obedience,...)**

Faith – Prayer – Fasting

Mark 9:14-29 (New Life Version, NLV)

14 When Jesus came back to His followers, He saw many people standing around them. The teachers of the Law were arguing with them. 15 The people saw Jesus and were surprised and ran to greet Him. 16 Jesus asked the teachers of the Law, “What are you arguing about with them?”

17 One of the people said, "Teacher, I brought my son to You. He has a demon in him and cannot talk. 18 Wherever the demon takes him, it throws him down. Spit runs from his mouth. He grinds his teeth. He is getting weaker. I asked Your followers to put the demon out but they could not." 19 He said, "**You people of this day have no faith.** How long must I be with you? How long must I put up with you? Bring the boy to Me." 20 They brought the boy to Jesus. **The demon saw Jesus and at once held the boy in his power.** The boy fell to the ground with spit running from his mouth. 21 Jesus asked the boy's father, "How long has he been like this?" The father said, "From the time he was a child. 22 Many times it throws him into the fire and into the water to kill him. If You can do anything to help us, take pity on us!" 23 **Jesus said to him, "Why do you ask Me that? The one who has faith can do all things."** 24 At once the father cried out. He said with tears in his eyes, "Lord, I have faith. Help my weak faith to be stronger!" 25 Jesus saw that many people were gathering together in a hurry. He spoke sharp words to the demon. He said, "Demon! You who cannot speak or hear, I say to you, come out of him! Do not ever go into him again." 26 The demon gave a cry. It threw the boy down and came out of him. The boy was so much like a dead man that people said, "He is dead!" 27 But Jesus took him by the hand and helped him and he stood up. 28 When Jesus went into the house, His followers asked Him when He was alone, "**Why could we not put out the demon?**" 29 He said to them, "**The only way this kind of demon is put out is by prayer and by going without food so you can pray better.**"

God wants you to have everything you want...but He wants you to want Him first

1 John 3:22 (AMP)

and we receive from Him whatever we ask because we [carefully and consistently] keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight [habitually seeking to follow His plan for us].

1 John 5:14-15 (AMP)

14 This is the [remarkable degree of] confidence which we [as believers are entitled to] have before Him: that if we ask anything according to His will, [that is, consistent with His plan and purpose] He hears us. 15 And if we know [for a fact, as indeed we do] that He hears and listens to us in whatever we ask, we [also] know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted to us] the requests which we have asked from Him.

God gives us everything we need

Hebrews 12:5-11 (The Message, MSG)

5-11 Or have you forgotten how good parents treat children, and that God regards you as his children? My dear child, don't shrug off God's discipline, but don't be crushed by it either. It's the child he loves that he disciplines; the child he embraces, he also corrects. God is educating you; that's why you must never drop out. He's treating you as dear children. This trouble you're in isn't punishment; it's training, the normal experience of children. Only irresponsible parents leave children to fend for themselves. Would you prefer an irresponsible God? We respect our own parents for training and not spoiling us, so why not embrace God's training so we can truly live? While we were children, our parents did what seemed best to them. But God is doing what is best for us, training us to live God's holy best. **At the time, discipline isn't much fun. It always feels like it's going against the grain. Later, of course, it pays off handsomely, for it's the well-trained who find themselves mature in their relationship with God.**

Proverbs 3:5-12 (MSG)

5-12 Trust God from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for God's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Run to God! Run from evil! Your body will glow with health, your very bones will vibrate with life! **Honor God with everything you own; give him the first and the best.** Your barns will burst, your wine vats will brim over. But **don't, dear friend, resent God's discipline; don't sulk under his loving correction. It's the child he loves that God corrects; a father's delight is behind all this.**

Proverbs 3:11 (NLT)

My child, don't reject the Lord's discipline, and don't be upset when he corrects you.

Everything

- **What do you do when your problem is bigger than your faith?**
- **Your problems should always be bigger than your faith; but your problems should never be bigger than what you believe.**
- **Belief comes by grace and receiving; faith comes by hearing what you say you believe (only) in Christ.**
- **How do I make sure I believe so I can walk by faith so I can live in the reality of EVERYTHING!?**

Matthew 21:22 (AMP)

And whatever you ask for in prayer, believing, you will receive."

Mark 9:23 (AMP)

Jesus said to him, "[You say to Me,] 'If You can?' All things are possible for the one who believes and trusts [in Me]!"

Mark 11:24 (AMP)

For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God's will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you.

Hebrews 11:6 (AMP)

But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him.

John 6:28-29 (AMP)

28 Then they asked Him, "What are we to do, so that we may habitually be doing the works of God?" 29 Jesus answered, "This is the work of God: that you believe [adhere to, trust in, rely on, and have faith] in the One whom He has sent."
