Sermon Notes from July 23, 2017

**God gives us everything we need. Even if we don't like it.**

### **Hebrews 12:5-11 (The Message, MSG)**

5-11 Or have you forgotten how good parents treat children, and that God regards you as his children? My dear child, don't shrug off God's discipline, but don't be crushed by it either. It's the child he loves that he disciplines; the child he embraces, he also corrects. God is educating you; that's why you must never drop out. He's treating you as dear children. This trouble you're in isn't punishment; it's training, the normal experience of children. Only irresponsible parents leave children to fend for themselves. Would you prefer an irresponsible God? We respect our own parents for training and not spoiling us, so why not embrace God's training so we can truly live? While we were children, our parents did what seemed best to them. But God is doing what is best for us, training us to live God's holy best. **At the time, discipline isn't much fun. It always feels like it's going against the grain. Later, of course, it pays off handsomely, for it's the well-trained who find themselves mature in their relationship with God.**

### **Proverbs 3:5-12 (MSG)**

5-12 Trust God from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. Listen for God's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Run to God! Run from evil! Your body will glow with health, your very bones will vibrate with life! **Honor God with everything you own; give him the first and the best.** Your barns will burst, your wine vats will brim over. But **don't, dear friend, resent God's discipline; don't sulk under his loving correction. It's the child he loves that God corrects; a father's delight is behind all this.**

### **Proverbs 3:11 (New Living Translation, NLT)**

My child, don't reject the Lord's discipline, and don't be upset when he corrects you.

## **God wants me to have everything I need and everything I want.**

### ➤ **Why? Because I am learning to want what He wants.**

#### **Psalm 37:4 (Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, AMPC)**

4 Delight yourself also in the Lord, and He will give you the desires and secret petitions of your heart.

#### **Psalm 37:3-4 (MSG)**

3-4 Get insurance with God and do a good deed, settle down and stick to your last. Keep company with God, get in on the best.

## **Everything**

- **What do you do when your problem is bigger than your faith?**
- **Your problems should always be bigger than your faith; but your problems should never be bigger than what you believe.**
- **Belief comes by grace and receiving; faith comes by hearing what you say you believe (only) in Christ.**
- **How do I make sure I believe so I can walk by faith so I can live in the reality of EVERYTHING!?**

#### **Matthew 21:22 (AMP)**

And whatever you ask for in prayer, believing, you will receive.”

#### **Mark 9:23 (AMP)**

Jesus said to him, “[You say to Me,] ‘If You can?’ All things are possible for the one who believes and trusts [in Me]!”

#### **Mark 11:24 (AMP)**

For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you.

#### **Hebrews 11:6 (AMP)**

But without faith it is impossible to [walk with God and] please Him, for whoever comes [near] to God must [necessarily] believe that God exists and that He rewards those who [earnestly and diligently] seek Him.

#### **John 6:28-29 (AMP)**

28 Then they asked Him, “What are we to do, so that we may habitually be doing the works of God?” 29 Jesus answered, “This is the work of God: that you believe [adhere to, trust in, rely on, and have faith] in the One whom He has sent.”
