EVERYTHING

2 Peter 1:2-4 (New Living Translation, NLT)

2 May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord. 3 By his divine power, **God has given us everything we need for living a godly life.** We have received all of this by coming to know Him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. 4 And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires.

God wants me to have everything I need and everything I want as I make Him first in my life

Matthew 6:30-33 (AMP)

30 But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive and green today and tomorrow is [cut and] thrown [as fuel] into the furnace, will He not much more clothe you? You of little faith!
31 Therefore do not worry or be anxious (perpetually uneasy, distracted), saying, 'What are we going to eat?' or 'What are we going to drink?' or 'What are we going to wear?' 32 For the [pagan] Gentiles eagerly seek all these things; [but do not worry,] for **your heavenly Father knows that you need them.** 33 But **first and most importantly seek (aim at, strive after) His kingdom and His righteousness [His way of doing and being right—the attitude and character of God]**, and all these things will be given to you also.

God wants you to have everything you want... but He wants you to want Him first

1 John 3:22 (AMP)

and we receive from Him whatever we ask because we [carefully and consistently] keep His commandments and do the things that are pleasing in His sight [habitually seeking to follow His plan for us].

1 John 5:14-15 (AMP)

14 This is the [remarkable degree of] confidence which we [**as believers** are entitled to] have before Him: that if we ask anything according to His will, [that is, consistent with His plan and purpose] He hears us. 15 And if we know [for a fact, as indeed we do] that He hears and listens to us in whatever we ask, we [also] know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted to us] the requests which we have asked from Him.

unBELIEVEABLE!

Mark 9:14-25 (New King James Version, NKJV)

14 And when He came to the disciples, He saw a great multitude around them, and scribes disputing with them. 15 Immediately, when they saw Him, all the people were greatly amazed, and running to Him, greeted Him. 16 And He asked the scribes, "What are you discussing with them?" 17 Then one of the crowd answered and said, "Teacher, I brought You my son, who has a mute spirit. 18 And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. So I spoke to Your disciples, that they should cast it out, but they could not." 19 He answered him and said, "**O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you? Bring him to Me.**" 20 Then they brought him to Him. And when he saw Him, immediately the spirit convulsed him, and he fell on the ground and wallowed, foaming at the mouth. 21 So He asked his father, "How long has this been happening to him?" And he said, "From childhood. 22 And often he has thrown him both into the fire and into the water to destroy him. But if You can do anything, have compassion on us and help us." 23 **Jesus said to him, "If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes."** 24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "**Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!**" 25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, He rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it: "Deaf and dumb spirit, I command you, come out of him and enter him no more!"

You were born to do the unBELIEVEABLE!

- **You were created to be the solution to problems!**
- **Your problems should always be bigger than your faith, but your problems should never be bigger than what you believe.**

John 6:28-29 (AMP)

28 Then they asked Him, "What are we to do, so that we may habitually be doing the works of God?" 29 Jesus answered, "**This is the work of God: that you believe [adhere to, trust in, rely on, and have faith] in the One whom He has sent.**"

Position yourself to be the solution and not the problem

- **When wrong people leave right things happen!**
- **You will only be remembered in life for one of two things...The problems you solve or the problems you create.**

- **Whatever problem you have begin believing God, walking in faith, hoping for the best and resting in unfailing Love. There is a solution; you have it or someone is walking around with it. 1 Corinthians 13:13**

We need to pray for our leaders because they are walking around with some of our answers and we are the answer to some of their problems.

1 Timothy 2:1-2 (Easy-to-Read Version, ERV)

1 First of all, I ask that you pray for all people. Ask God to bless them and give them what they need. And give thanks. 2 You should pray for rulers and for all who have authority. Pray for these leaders so that we can live quiet and peaceful lives—lives full of devotion to God and respect for him.

Jeremiah 29:7 (ERV)

Also, do good things for the city I sent you to. Pray to the Lord for the city you are living in, because if there is peace in that city, you will have peace also.”

How do I receive EVERYTHING

Romans 13:1-7 (NLT)

1 Everyone must submit to governing authorities. For all authority comes from God, and those in positions of authority have been placed there by God. 2 So anyone who rebels against authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and they will be punished. 3 For the authorities do not strike fear in people who are doing right, but in those who are doing wrong. Would you like to live without fear of the authorities? Do what is right, and they will honor you. 4 The authorities are God’s servants, sent for your good. But if you are doing wrong, of course you should be afraid, for they have the power to punish you. They are God’s servants, sent for the very purpose of punishing those who do what is wrong. 5 So you must submit to them, not only to avoid punishment, but also to keep a clear conscience. 6 Pay your taxes, too, for these same reasons. For government workers need to be paid. They are serving God in what they do. 7 Give to everyone what you owe them: Pay your taxes and government fees to those who collect them, and **give respect and honor to those who are in authority.**
