God Loves us!

John 3:16 (New International Version, NIV)

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Romans 5:8 (NIV)

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

He is not dead, He is alive!

1 Corinthians 15:4 (New Living Translation, NLT)

He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said.

Acts 2:32-33 (NIV)

32 God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of it. 33 Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear.

I love Him for what He has done for me, but my love is inconsistent.

1 John 4:7-10 (NLT)

7 Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. 8 But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love. 9 God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. 10 This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

Romans 8:1 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

Therefore, [there is] now no condemnation (no adjudging guilty of wrong) for those who are in Christ Jesus, who live [and] walk not after the dictates of the flesh, but after the dictates of the Spirit.

I need God's Love! My love is not sufficient enough to live by faith.

1 John 4:7 (NIV)

Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

Romans 5:5 (NLT)

And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because **He has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with His love**.

- **All I need to do is receive! My feelings are not involved; it is according to my Faith!**
- **My faith or my doubt translates to feeling.**

Ingredients to improve faith and develop the God kind of Love.

2 Peter 1:5-9 (Contemporary English Version, CEV)

5 Do your best to **improve your faith**. You can do this by **adding goodness, understanding, 6 self-control, patience, devotion to God, 7 concern for others, and love**. 8 If you keep growing in this way, it will show that what you know about our Lord Jesus Christ has made your lives useful and meaningful. 9 But if you don't grow, you are like someone who is nearsighted or blind, and you have forgotten that your past sins are forgiven.

You may have the ingredients, but they need to be stirred up!

2 Timothy 1:6 (New King James Version, NKJV)

Therefore I remind you to stir up the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands.

Psalm 34:8 (NKJV)

Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!

- 1. Virtue (excellence, resolution, Christian energy)/pineapple juice**
- 2. Knowledge (intelligence)/mustard**
- 3. Self-control/cloves**
- 4. [Develop] steadfastness (patience, endurance)/cinnamon**
- 5. Godliness (piety)/honey**
- 6. [Develop] brotherly affection/brown sugar**
