God Loves us! God is Love. God requests for me to Love. I can't Love as God requests on my own.

God's Son (*Jesus*) gave us His Spirit so we could receive God's Love.

Jesus lived so I could be forgiven and so I could have His Spirit to live victorious in this sinful world.

Jesus did what I could not do...live a sinless life. So He died so I could have His Spirit, which happens to be Holy.

Have you received Christ as your Savior?

When I receive Jesus's Spirit by faith, God can pour out His Love in my heart, giving me the ability to Love like God.

When I Love like God I get God type results.

Have you asked for His Spirit to "*live*" in you?

- **Understanding how we love could enhance our lives; *physically, mentally, and Spiritually.***

The man kind of love

- **Storge - natural affectionate love; It is natural affection, like that felt by parents for their children.**

Matthew 7:9-11 (The Living Bible, TLB)

9 If a child asks his father for a loaf of bread, will he be given a stone instead? 10 If he asks for fish, will he be given a poisonous snake? Of course not! 11 And if you hard-hearted, sinful men know how to give good gifts to your children, won't your Father in heaven even more certainly give good gifts to those who ask him for them?

Matthew 7:9-11 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

9 Or what man is there of you, if his son asks him for a loaf of bread, will hand him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, will hand him a serpent? 11 If you then, evil as you are, know how to give good and advantageous gifts to your children, how much more will your Father Who is in heaven [perfect as He is] give good and advantageous things to those who keep on asking Him!

- **Eros - physical love, passionate, sensual, sexual love and desire**

Song of Solomon 1:1-4 (TLB)

The Girl: 2 "Kiss me again and again, for your love is sweeter than wine. 3 How fragrant your cologne, and how great your name! No wonder all the young girls love you! 4 Take me with you; come, let's run!"

Song of Solomon 4:1-7 (TLB)

1 King Solomon: "How beautiful you are, my love, how beautiful! Your eyes are those of doves. Your hair falls across your face like flocks of goats that frisk across the slopes of Gilead. 2 Your teeth are white as sheep's wool, newly shorn and washed; perfectly matched, without one missing. 3 Your lips are like a thread of scarlet—and how beautiful your mouth. Your cheeks are matched loveliness behind your locks. 4 Your neck is stately as the tower of David, jeweled with a thousand heroes' shields. 5 Your breasts are like twin fawns of a gazelle, feeding among the lilies. 6 Until the morning dawns and the shadows flee away, I will go to the mountain of myrrh and to the hill of frankincense. 7 You are so beautiful, my love, in every part of you.

- **Philia - mental love, combining form denoting fondness, especially an abnormal love for or inclination towards a specified thing: pedophilia.**
 - **Friendly feeling toward (Francophilia)**
 - **Tendency toward (hemophilia)**
 - **Abnormal appetite or liking for (necrophilia)**

1 Thessalonians 4:9 (New King James Version, NKJV)

9 But concerning brotherly love (philadelphia) you have no need that I should write to you, for you yourselves are taught by God to love (Agape) one another;

The God kind of Love

- **Agape - Spiritual unconditional Love. This love is selfless; it gives and expects nothing in return.**

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (New Living Translation, NLT)

4 Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud 5 or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged. 6 It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. 7 Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.
