ASK in Prayer!

Matthew 21:22 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

And whatever you ask for in prayer, believing, you will receive.”

Mark 11:24 (AMP)

For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you.

Matthew 18:19 (AMP)

“Again I say to you, that if two believers on earth agree [that is, are of one mind, in harmony] about anything that they ask [within the will of God], it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.

Matthew 7:7-8 (AMP)

7 “Ask and keep on asking and it will be given to you; seek and keep on seeking and you will find; knock and keep on knocking and the door will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who keeps on asking receives, and he who keeps on seeking finds, and to him who keeps on knocking, it will be opened.

Ask in FAITH

James 1:5-8 (AMP)

5 If any of you lacks wisdom [to guide him through a decision or circumstance], he is to ask of [our benevolent] God, who gives to everyone generously and without rebuke or blame, and it will be given to him. 6 But he must ask [for wisdom] in faith, without doubting [God’s willingness to help], for the one who doubts is like a billowing surge of the sea that is blown about and tossed by the wind. 7 For such a person ought not to think or expect that he will receive anything [at all] from

the Lord, 8 being a double-minded man, unstable and restless in all his ways [in everything he thinks, feels, or decides].

You have not because you ASK not...with correct motives

James 4:2-3 (AMP)

2 You are jealous and covet [what others have] and your lust goes unfulfilled; so you murder. You are envious and cannot obtain [the object of your envy]; so you fight and battle. You do not have because you do not ask [it of God]. 3 You ask [God for something] and do not receive it, because you ask with wrong motives [out of selfishness or with an unrighteous agenda], so that [when you get what you want] you may spend it on your [hedonistic] desires.

James 4:2-3 (Contemporary English Version, CEV)

2 You want something you don't have, and you will do anything to get it. You will even kill! But you still cannot get what you want, and you won't get it by fighting and arguing. You should pray for it. 3 Yet even when you do pray, your prayers are not answered, because you pray just for selfish reasons.

The Answer is in The Question

- **Who am I?**
- **What is my Purpose?**
- **Why me?**
- **How do I accomplish this monumental task?**

Who am I?

- **Be bold enough to ask, strong enough to hear and the courage to be.**
- **The answer to this question will:**
 - 1. request for a renewed mind**
 - 2. require a repentant heart**
 - 3. refocus my direction and reality**

Who am I? Who am I will lead you to who "I am" Is

Matthew 10:39 (The Message, MSG)

"If your first concern is to look after yourself, you'll never find yourself. But if you forget about yourself and look to me, you'll find both yourself and me."

What is my Purpose?

- **When people fail to understand the purpose of their life abuse is inevitable.**
- **Embracing your purpose also means embracing the necessary changes**

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (Amplified Bible, Classic Edition, AMPC)

16 Every Scripture is God-breathed (given by His inspiration) and profitable for instruction, for reproof and **conviction of sin**, for **correction** of error and **discipline in obedience**, [and] for **training** in righteousness (**in holy living, in conformity to God's will in thought, purpose, and action**), 17 So that the people of God may be complete and proficient, well fitted and thoroughly equipped for every good work.

- **What would happen if His Purpose becomes my Purpose?**

Romans 8:28 (New Living Translation (NLT))

And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.

Why Me!!!?

- **Discovering Who You Were Born To Be will many times make you ask....Why Me!?**
- **Who we were born to be is typically much greater than how we think of ourselves. Either we think too highly of ourselves or too low. We need to pray to be aligned with God's thoughts of us.**

Judges 6:11-16 (NLT)

11 Then the angel of the Lord came and sat beneath the great tree at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash of the clan of Abiezer. Gideon son of Joash was threshing wheat at the bottom of a winepress to hide the grain from the Midianites. 12 The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, "Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!" 13 "Sir," Gideon replied, "if the Lord is with us, why has all this happened to us? And where are all the miracles our ancestors told us about? Didn't they say, 'The Lord brought us up out of Egypt'? But now the Lord has abandoned us and handed us over to the Midianites." 14 Then the Lord turned to him and said, "Go with the strength you have, and rescue Israel from the Midianites. I am sending you!" 15 "But Lord," Gideon replied, "how can I rescue Israel? My clan is the weakest in the whole tribe of Manasseh, and I am the least in my entire family!" 16 The Lord said to him, "I will be with you. And you will destroy the Midianites as if you were fighting against one man."

How do I accomplish this monumental task

2 Corinthians 5:7 (AMP)

7 for we walk by faith, not by sight [**living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God's promises**]

Matthew 17:19-20 (New King James Version, NKJV)

19 Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" 20 So Jesus said to them, "**Because of your little faith; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.**
