Honor – Heart - Harvest

2 Corinthians 9:6-13 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

6 [Remember] this: he who sows sparingly and grudgingly will also reap sparingly and grudgingly, and he who sows generously [that blessings may come to someone] will also reap generously and with blessings. 7 Let each one [give] as he has made up his own mind and purposed in his heart, not reluctantly or sorrowfully or under compulsion, for God loves (He [takes pleasure in, prizes above other things, and is unwilling to abandon or to do without) a cheerful (joyous, “prompt to do it”) giver [whose heart is in his giving]. 8 And God is able to make all grace (every favor and [earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]. 9 As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor; His deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever! 10 And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity]. 11 Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God. 12 For the service that the ministering of this fund renders does not only fully supply what is lacking to the saints (God’s people), but it also overflows in many [cries of] thanksgiving to God. 13 Because at [your] standing of the test of this ministry, they will glorify God for your loyalty and obedience to the Gospel of Christ which you confess, as well as for your generous-hearted liberality to them and to all [the other needy ones].

How to sow and reap

- **Your Tithe & Offering is personal. Your Sowing & Reaping is business.**
- **Sowing is God’s increase system given to us on earth. This system is used to help us manage and determine the flow and quality of our lives in the earth realm.**
- **Reaping (equally important) is the system of return based on your**

cooperation and acceptance of His grace, the quantity of the seed and the quality of the ground.

- **The system of sowing & reaping builds faith, endurance and trust in God's system toward your sufficiency on earth; it is the way we take care of ourselves on earth.**

Understanding how to sow and reap helps me not to pray for things God has already made available.

- **For example, I don't need to pray for more seed because God says He gives SEED to the SOWER.**

2 Corinthians 9:10 (AMP)

And [God] **Who provides seed for the sower** and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].

If you knew for SURE you would reap, what would you sow?

How to Sow & Reap

- **Honor the system: fasting - faith - favor – future**

2 Corinthians 9:6 (AMP)

6 [Remember] this: he who sows sparingly and grudgingly will also reap sparingly and grudgingly, and he who sows generously [that blessings may come to someone] will also reap generously and with blessings.

Luke 16:10-12 (New Living Translation, NLT)

10 "If you are faithful in little things, you will be faithful in large ones. But if you are dishonest in little things, you won't be honest with greater responsibilities. 11 And if you are untrustworthy about worldly wealth, who will trust you with the true riches of heaven? 12 And if you are not faithful with other people's things, why should you be trusted with things of your own?"

- **A clean Heart to give as God says: recognize - renew - receive - reap**

2 Corinthians 9:6-7 (AMP)

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The condition of your Heart determines the quality and quantity of your harvest

- **You cannot harvest if there is no seed.**
- **You only reap a good harvest in good soil.**

Matthew 13:18-23 (AMP)

18 Listen then to the [meaning of the] parable of the sower: 19 While anyone is hearing the Word of the kingdom and does not grasp and comprehend it, the evil one comes and **snatches away what was sown in his heart**. This is what was sown along the roadside. 20 As for what was sown on thin (rocky) soil, this is he who hears the Word and at once welcomes and accepts it with joy; 21 Yet it **has no real root in him**, but is temporary (inconstant, lasts but a little while); and when affliction or trouble or persecution comes on account of the Word, at once he is caused to stumble [he is repelled and begins to distrust and desert Him Whom he ought to trust and obey] and he falls away. 22 As for what was sown among thorns, this is he who hears the Word, but the cares of the world and the pleasure and delight and glamour and deceitfulness of riches choke and suffocate the Word, and it **yields no fruit**. 23 As for what was sown on good soil, this is he who hears the Word and grasps and comprehends it; he indeed bears fruit and yields in one case a hundred times as much as was sown, in another sixty times as much, and in another thirty.

- **God wants you to receive a full Harvest. The purpose of your Harvest is to take care of you and others.**

2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (AMP)

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
