Foundational Scripture

2 Chronicles 7:14-16 (Amplified Bible)

14 If My people, who are called by My name, shall humble themselves, pray, seek, crave, and require of necessity My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.

15 Now My eyes will be open and My ears attentive to prayer offered in this place.

16 For I have chosen and sanctified (set apart for holy use) this house, that My Name may be here forever, and My eyes and My heart will be here perpetually.

Attitude: A Definition

- manner, disposition, feeling, position, etc., with regard to a person or thing; tendency or orientation, especially of the mind:
- a way of thinking or acting, etc.
Example: *What is your attitude toward politics?*
- outlook **Synonyms:** air, angle, approach, belief, bent, bias, character, demeanor, disposition, head-set, inclination, leaning, mental state, mind-set, mindset^{*}, mindtrip^{*}, mood, notion, opinion, perspective, philosophy, position, posture, predilection, prejudice, proclivity, reaction, routine, say so^{*}, sensibility, sentiment, set, slant, stance, stand, standing, standpoint, temper, temperament, twist, view

Position: A Definition

1. condition with reference to place; location; situation. 2. a place occupied or to be occupied; site: *a fortified position*. 3. the proper, appropriate, or usual place: *out of position*. 4. **situation or condition, esp. with relation to favorable or unfavorable circumstances:** *to be in an awkward position; to bargain from a position of strength*.

The attitude of a person controls the position that they are in!

3 John 1:2 (King James Version)

2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Create, using faith Words!

Deuteronomy 28:8 (The Message)

8 God will order a blessing on your barns and workplaces; he'll bless you in the land that God, your God, is giving you.

Deuteronomy 28:11 (Amplified Bible)

11 And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you.

Deuteronomy 28:13 (New Living Translation)

13 If you listen to these commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom.

Joshua 1:8 (New Living Translation)

8 Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do.

Prostrate myself before God

Deuteronomy 9:18 (New International Version)

18 Then once again I fell prostrate before the LORD for forty days and forty nights; I ate no bread and drank no water, because of all the sin you had committed, doing what was evil in the LORD's sight and so provoking him to anger.

Joshua 6:1-7 (New Living Translation)

1 Now the gates of Jericho were tightly shut because the people were afraid of the Israelites. No one was allowed to go out or in. 2 But the Lord said to Joshua, "I have given you Jericho, its king, and all its strong warriors. 3 You and your fighting men should march around the town once a day for six days. 4 Seven priests will walk ahead of the Ark, each carrying a ram's horn. On the seventh day you are to march around the town seven times, with the priests blowing the horns. 5 When you hear the priests give one long blast on the rams' horns, have all the people shout as loud as they can. Then the walls of the town will collapse, and the people can charge straight into the town." 6 So Joshua called together the priests and said, "Take up the Ark of the Lord's Covenant, and assign seven priests to walk in front of it, each carrying a ram's horn." 7 Then he gave orders to the people: "March around the town, and the armed men will lead the way in front of the Ark of the Lord."

John 6:5-13 (New Living Translation)

5 Jesus soon saw a huge crowd of people coming to look for him. Turning to Philip, he asked, "Where can we buy bread to feed all these people?" 6 He was testing Philip, for he already knew what he was going to do. 7 Philip replied, "Even if we worked for months, we wouldn't have enough money to feed them!" 8 Then Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, spoke up. 9 "There's a young boy here with five barley loaves and two fish. But what good is that with this huge crowd?" 10 "Tell everyone to sit down," Jesus said. So they all sat down on the grassy slopes. (The men alone numbered about 5,000.) 11 Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks to God, and distributed them to the people. Afterward he did the same with the fish. And they all ate as much as they wanted. 12 After everyone was full, Jesus told his disciples, "Now gather the leftovers, so that nothing is wasted." 13 So they picked up the pieces and filled twelve baskets with scraps left by the people who had eaten from the five barley loaves.
