### **STOP WORRYING!**

#### **Matthew 24:22 (Amplified Bible)**

22 And if those days had not been shortened, no human being would endure and survive, but for the sake of the elect (God's chosen ones) those days will be shortened.

### **God is not surprised! He is paying attention!**

#### **Matthew 10:30 (The Message)**

29-31 "What's the price of a pet canary? Some loose change, right? And God cares what happens to it even more than you do. **He pays even greater attention to you, down to the last detail—even numbering the hairs on your head!** So don't be intimidated by all this bully talk. You're worth more than a million canaries.

#### **2 Chronicles 7:14 (Amplified Bible)**

14 If My people, who are called by My name, shall humble themselves, pray, seek, crave, and require of necessity My face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven, forgive their sin, and heal their land.

### **Everything is going to be alright!**

#### **1 John 5:4 (Amplified Bible)**

For whatever is born of God is victorious over the world; and this is the victory that conquers the world, even our faith.

#### **1 John 5:4 (Contemporary English Version)**

Every child of God can defeat the world, and our faith is what gives us this victory.

### **How can I be sure?**

- **Because God cannot lie!**

#### **Titus 1:2 (New King James Version)**

2 in hope of eternal life which **God, who cannot lie**, promised before time began,



**Hebrews 6:18 (New Living Translation)**

18 So God has given both his promise and his oath. These two things are unchangeable because **it is impossible for God to lie**. Therefore, we who have fled to him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us.

- **Jesus Is The Truth!**

**John 14:6 (New King James Version)**

6 Jesus said to him, **"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.**

**Ephesians 4:21 (Amplified Bible)**

21 Assuming that you have really heard Him and been taught by Him, as **[all] Truth is in Jesus** [embodied and personified in Him],

**Jeremiah 29:11 (New Living Translation)**

11 For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

- **God will not change what he promised you!**

**Malachi 3:6 (The Message)**

"I am God—yes, I Am. I haven't changed. And because I haven't changed, you, the descendants of Jacob, haven't been destroyed. You have a long history of ignoring my commands. You haven't done a thing I've told you. Return to me so I can return to you,"

**Hebrews 13:8 (New Living Translation)**

8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

- **He said He would never leave you!**

**Deuteronomy 31:8 (New International Version)**

8 The LORD himself goes before you and will be with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."

**John 3:16 (Contemporary English Version)**

16 God loved the people of this world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who has faith in him will have eternal life and never really die.



**I need to work on not leaving God, because He is not going to leave me!**

**Deuteronomy 31:6 (New Living Translation)**

6 So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you."

**How can I be sure?**

- **Because God is Faithful**
- **God will not let you down!**
- **There is an answer!**

**1 Corinthians 10:13 (The Message)**

13 No test or temptation that comes your way is beyond the course of what others have had to face. All you need to remember is that God will never let you down; he'll never let you be pushed past your limit; he'll always be there to help you come through it.

**1 Corinthians 10:13 (New Living Translation)**

13 The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.

- **He is my heavenly Father.**

**Matthew 7:9-11 (Contemporary English Version)**

9 Would any of you give your hungry child a stone, if the child asked for some bread?

10 Would you give your child a snake if the child asked for a fish? 11 As bad as you are, you still know how to give good gifts to your children. But your heavenly Father is even more ready to give good things to people who ask.

**Matthew 7:9-11 (The Message)**

7-11 "Don't bargain with God. Be direct. Ask for what you need. This isn't a cat-and-mouse, hide-and-seek game we're in. If your child asks for bread, do you trick him with sawdust? If he asks for fish, do you scare him with a live snake on his plate? As bad as you are, you wouldn't think of such a thing. You're at least decent to your own children. So don't you think the God who conceived you in love will be even better?"



### **Matthew 7:9-11 (New King James Version)**

9 Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? 10 Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent? 11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

### **Romans 8:31-39 (New Living Translation)**

31 What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? **If God is for us, who can ever be against us?** 32 Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, **won't he also give us everything else?** 33 Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? No one—for God himself has given us right standing with himself. 34 Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and **he is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us.** 35 Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? 36 (As the Scriptures say, "For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.") 37 No, **despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.** 38 **And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love.** Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. 39 No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

### **Galatians 6:9 (New Living Translation)**

9 So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

### **Isaiah 26:3 (New Living Translation)**

3 You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

**How do you know that everything is going to work out?**
