Encourage

Part of Speech: verb

Definition: To impart courage, inspiration, and resolution to; to inspire with courage, spirit, or confidence; to impart strength and confidence to.

Synonyms: animate, cheer, embolden, inspire, inspirit, motivate; buck up, cheer, hearten, nerve, perk up

Worry Defined

1a: mental distress or agitation resulting from concern usually for something impending or anticipated: anxiety; b: an instance or occurrence of such distress or agitation; to torment oneself with or suffer from disturbing thoughts; fret; to torment with cares, anxieties, etc.; trouble; plague.

Win over Worry – Faith

Romans 12:3 (Contemporary English Version)

3I realize how kind God has been to me, and so I tell each of you not to think you are better than you really are. Use good sense and measure yourself by the amount of faith that God has given you.

- Don't put more on yourself than you can handle.
- God Has given you a measure of faith.

God never responds to your need – He only responds to your Faith!

Hebrews 4:16 (New Living Translation)

16 So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.



Ephesians 4:28 (New Living Translation)

28 If you are a thief, quit stealing. Instead, use your hands for good hard work, and then give generously to others in need.

2 Corinthians 9:6-8 (New Living Translation)

6 Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. 7 You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully." 8 And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others.
