The Mission

- **To educate the body of Christ on who we are so we quit receiving who the enemy says we are.**
- **To equip the body of Christ with Word and precepts to understand and know who we are.**
- **To empower the body of Christ with Word and understanding to win in every area of life!**

Who Are You?

- **People who don't know who they are often quit at the challenge of the enemy, then they have to live with being overpowered and attacked by the enemy.**

Acts 19:11-16 (New Living Translation)

11 God gave Paul the power to perform unusual miracles. 12 When handkerchiefs or aprons that had merely touched his skin were placed on sick people, they were healed of their diseases, and evil spirits were expelled.

13 A group of Jews was traveling from town to town casting out evil spirits. They tried to use the name of the Lord Jesus in their incantation, saying, "I command you in the name of Jesus, whom Paul preaches, to come out!" 14 Seven sons of Sceva, a leading priest, were doing this. 15 But one time when they tried it, the evil spirit replied, "I know Jesus, and I know Paul, but who are you?" 16 Then the man with the evil spirit leaped on them, overpowered them, and attacked them with such violence that they fled from the house, naked and battered.

Who Am I?

- **When God reveals to you who you are it will ALWAYS be greater than what you think that you can accomplish.**

Exodus 3:11-13 (New Living Translation)

11 "But **who am I** to appear before Pharaoh?" Moses asked God. "How can you expect me to lead the Israelites out of Egypt?" 12 Then God told him, "I will be with you. And this will serve as proof that I have sent you: When you have brought the Israelites out of Egypt, you will return here to worship God at this very mountain." 13 But Moses protested, "If I go to the people of Israel and tell them, 'The God of your ancestors has sent me to you,' they won't believe me. They will ask, 'Which god are you talking about? What is his name?' Then what should I tell them?"

- **I am redeemed from the curse of the law!**

Galatians 3:13 (The Message)

13-14 Christ redeemed us from that self-defeating, cursed life by absorbing it completely into himself. Do you remember the Scripture that says, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"? That is what happened when Jesus was nailed to the cross: He became a curse, and at the same time dissolved the curse. And now, because of that, the air is cleared and we can see that Abraham's blessing is present and available for non-Jews, too. We are all able to receive God's life, his Spirit, in and with us by believing—just the way Abraham received it.

- **I am redeemed from the hand of the enemy!**

Psalm 107:2 (New King James Version)

2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say *so*, Whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy,

Psalm 107:2 (New Living Translation)

2 Has the Lord redeemed you? Then speak out! Tell others he has redeemed you from your enemies.

- **I am healed by His wounds!**

1 Peter 2:24 (New Living Translation)

24 He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed.

- **I am forgiven!**

Ephesians 1:7-8 (Contemporary English Version)

7-8 Christ sacrificed his life's blood to set us free, which means that our sins are now forgiven. Christ did this because God was so kind to us. God has great wisdom and understanding,

- **I am a new person!**

2 Corinthians 5:17 (New Living Translation)

17 This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

- **I am led by the spirit of God!**

Romans 8:14 (New Living Translation)

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

- **I am saved by grace through faith!**

Ephesians 2:8 (New King James Version)

8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God,

Ephesians 2:8 (New Living Translation)

8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God.

- **I am a child of God! I am an Heir!**

Romans 8:16 (Amplified Bible)

16 The Spirit Himself [thus] testifies together with our own spirit, [assuring us] that we are children of God.

Galatians 4:6-7 (New Living Translation)

6 And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." 7 Now you are no longer a slave but God's own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir.

- **I am a child of God, I am an heir of God, and a joint heir of Christ!**

Romans 8:17 (New Living Translation)

17 And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering.

- **I can defeat the enemy by the blood of Jesus and by the words of my testimony!**

Revelation 12:11 (New Living Translation)

11 And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony. And they did not love their lives so much that they were afraid to die.

- **I live by faith and not by my issues!**

2 Corinthians 5:7 (New King James Version)

7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

- **I am always kept safe!**

Isaiah 46:4 (Contemporary English Version)

4I will still be the same when you are old and gray, and I will take care of you. I created you. I will carry you and always keep you safe.

- **I am strong in the Lord and in His mighty power!**

Ephesians 6:10 (New Living Translation)

10 A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.

- **I am rescued from the dark power of the enemy.**

Colossians 1:13 (Contemporary English Version)

13God rescued us from the dark power of Satan and brought us into the kingdom of his dear Son,

- **I have been made right with God! And I also have peace with God because I received what Christ did for me.**

Romans 5:1 (New Living Translation)

1 Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.

- **I am blessed with every spiritual blessing!**

Ephesians 1:3 (New King James Version)

3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ,

- **I am the light of the world!**

Matthew 5:14 (New Living Translation)

14 "You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden.

- **I am an imitator of God!**

Ephesians 5:1 (New King James Version)

1 Therefore be imitators of God as dear children.

- **I am doing all things through Christ who strengthens me!**

Philippians 4:13 (New King James Version)

13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

- **I am more than a conqueror through Christ!**

Romans 8:37 (New King James Version)

37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

- **I am an heir of eternal life!**

1 John 5:11-12 (New King James Version)

11 And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. 12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
