#### **Mark 34:35-41**

35That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side."  
36Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. 37A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. 38Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" 39He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. 40He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" 41They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

#### **Matthew 10:39 (Contemporary English Version)**

### **Obedience – Partial obedience is disobedience.**

#### **1 Samuel 15:22 (New Living Translation)**

22 But Samuel replied, "What is more pleasing to the Lord: your burnt offerings and sacrifices or your obedience to his voice? Listen! Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission is better than offering the fat of rams.



### **1 John 2:3 (New Living Translation)**

#### **Proverbs 11:24 (New American Standard Bible)**

24 There is one who scatters, and yet increases all the more, And there is one who withholds what is justly due, and yet it results only in want.
