#### **People Give Up**

#### **Matthew 24:12 (The Message)**

11-12" In the confusion, lying preachers will come forward and deceive a lot of people. For many others, the overwhelming spread of evil will do them in—nothing left of their love but a mound of ashes.

#### **Romans 1:28 (New King James Version)**

28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting;

#### **2 Timothy 3:8 (New Living Translation)**

8 These teachers oppose the truth just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses. They have depraved minds and a counterfeit faith.

#### **Titus 1:16 (New King James Version)**

16 They profess to know God, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

#### **Revelation 3:15-16 (The Message)**

15-17" I know you inside and out, and find little to my liking. You're not cold, you're not hot—far better to be either cold or hot! You're stale (lukewarm). You're stagnant. You make me want to vomit.



### **Matthew 5:13 (The Message)**

13"Let me tell you why you are here. You're here to be salt-seasoning that brings out the God-flavors of this earth. If you lose your saltiness, how will people taste godliness? You've lost your usefulness and will end up in the garbage.

### **James 3:7-12 (The Message)**

7-10This is scary: You can tame a tiger, but you can't tame a tongue—it's never been done. The tongue runs wild, a wanton killer. With our tongues we bless God our Father; with the same tongues we curse the very men and women he made in his image. Curses and blessings out of the same mouth! 10-12My friends, this can't go on. A spring doesn't gush fresh water one day and brackish the next, does it? Apple trees don't bear strawberries, do they? Raspberry bushes don't bear apples, do they? You're not going to dip into a polluted mud hole and get a cup of clear, cool water, are you?

### **Matthew 7:13-14 (Amplified Bible)**

13Enter through the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and spacious and broad is the way that leads away to destruction, and many are those who are entering through it. 14But the gate is narrow (contracted by pressure) and the way is straitened and compressed that leads away to life, and few are those who find it.

### **Proverbs 14:12-13 (New Living Translation)**

12 There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death. 13 Laughter can conceal a heavy heart, but when the laughter ends, the grief remains.

### **Matthew 22:36-40 (New Living Translation)**

36 "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" 37 Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' 40 The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."

### **Mark 12:30-31 (New Living Translation)**

30 And you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.' 31 The second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' No other commandment is greater than these."



**Luke 10:27 (New Living Translation)**

27 The man answered, “‘You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind.’ And, ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’”

**Romans 6:13 (The Message)**

12-14 That means you must not give sin a vote in the way you conduct your lives. Don't give it the time of day. Don't even run little errands that are connected with that old way of life. Throw yourselves wholeheartedly and full-time—remember, you've been raised from the dead!—into God's way of doing things. Sin can't tell you how to live. After all, you're not living under that old tyranny any longer. You're living in the freedom of God.

**Matthew 5:6 (Amplified Bible)**

6 Blessed and fortunate and happy and spiritually prosperous (in that state in which the born-again child of God enjoys His favor and salvation) are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness (uprightness and right standing with God), for they shall be completely satisfied!

**While you are waiting submit your life to Jesus; He knows how to handle it better than you can!**

**2 Chronicles 7:14 (Contemporary English Version)**

14 If my own people will humbly pray and turn back to me and stop sinning, then I will answer them from heaven. I will forgive them and make their land fertile once again.

**1 John 1:9 (New Living Translation)**

9 But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

**Romans 10:9 (New Living Translation)**

9 If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

**1 John 5:14-15 (New Living Translation)**

14 And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. 15 And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for.
