I'm stuck! How do I know I am stuck?

- **I get very defensive when called on my failures**
- **I walk by sight instead of by faith**
- **Void of creativity**
- **I repetitiously make terrible decisions**
- **Depression**
- **I don't give because I am afraid I may not have...**

I'm stuck! How did I get stuck?

- **Using an old system in a new environment.**
- **Unable or unwilling to predict, perceive, or pray.**
- **My life shifted but my thinking didn't.**

Romans 12:2 (Contemporary English Version, CEV)

Don't be like the people of this world, but **let God change the way you think**. Then you will know how to do everything that is good and pleasing to him.

Reset: To set again.

- **Goal: Get myself out of a mundane daily grind that negatively affects my body, soul, and spirit.**
- **Goal: Reset my thinking and habits toward a plan of action that will consistently yield profitable results.**
- **Goal: Understand there is one thing that is constant...change; so I must learn how to RESET my life at will.**

Reset your life!

- **Focus - Structure**
- **Faith - Strategy**
- **Fire - Spirit (culture)**

Focus on your Structure

Luke 6:46-49 (New Living Translation, NLT)

46 “So why do you keep calling me ‘Lord, Lord!’ when you don’t do what I say? 47 I will show you what it’s like when someone comes to me, listens to my teaching, and then follows it. 48 It is like a person building a house who digs deep and lays the foundation on solid rock. When the floodwaters rise and break against that house, it stands firm because it is well built. 49 But **anyone who hears and doesn’t obey is like a person who builds a house without a foundation.** When the floods sweep down against that house, it will collapse into a heap of ruins.”

Luke 6:46-49 (The Message, MSG)

46-47 “Why are you so polite with me, always saying ‘Yes, sir,’ and ‘That’s right, sir,’ but never doing a thing I tell you? These words I speak to you are not mere additions to your life, homeowner improvements to your standard of living. **They are foundation words, words to build a life on.** 48-49 **“If you work the words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who dug deep and laid the foundation of his house on bedrock.** When the river burst its banks and crashed against the house, nothing could shake it; it was built to last. But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don’t work them into your life, you are like a dumb carpenter who built a house but skipped the foundation. When the swollen river came crashing in, it collapsed like a house of cards. It was a total loss.”

1 Corinthians 3:9-15 (MSG)

9-15 Or, to put it another way, you are God’s house. Using the gift God gave me as a good architect, I designed blueprints; Apollos is putting up the walls. Let each carpenter who comes on the job take care to build on the foundation! **Remember, there is only one foundation, the one already laid: Jesus Christ.** Take particular care in picking out your building materials. Eventually there is going to be an inspection. If you use cheap or inferior materials, you’ll be found out. The inspection will be thorough and rigorous. You won’t get by with a thing. If your work passes inspection, fine; if it doesn’t, your part of the building will be torn out and started over. But you won’t be torn out; you’ll survive—but just barely.

1 Corinthians 3:11-15 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

11 For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is [already] laid, which is Jesus Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One). 12 But if anyone builds upon the Foundation, whether it be with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, 13 The work of each [one] will become [plainly, openly] known (shown for what it is); for the day [of Christ] will disclose and declare it, because it will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test and critically appraise the character and worth of the work each person has done. 14 If the work which any person has built on this Foundation [any product of his efforts whatever] survives [this test], he will get his reward. 15 But if any person’s work is burned up [under the test], he will suffer the loss [of it all, losing his reward], though he himself will be saved, but only as [one who has passed] through fire.
