I know I am called to this: discover who you were born to be

Isaiah 61:1 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed and qualified me to preach the Gospel of good tidings to the meek, the poor, and afflicted; He has sent me to bind up and heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the [physical and spiritual] captives and the opening of the prison and of the eyes to those who are bound,

Proverbs 1:7 (Contemporary English Version, CEV)

Respect and obey the Lord! This is the beginning of knowledge. Only a fool rejects wisdom and good advice.

If I am not hungering and thirsting for God I am already deceived.

1 Corinthians 3:18 (AMP)

Let no person deceive himself. If anyone among you supposes that he is wise in this age, let him become a fool [let him discard his worldly discernment and recognize himself as dull, stupid, and foolish, without true learning and scholarship], that he may become [really] wise.

Matthew 5:6 (AMP)

Blessed and fortunate and happy and spiritually prosperous (in that state in which the born-again child of God enjoys His favor and salvation) are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness (uprightness and right standing with God), for they shall be completely satisfied!

Not to misJudge

Matthew 7:1-3 (New Living Translation, NLT)

1 "Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. 2 For you will be treated as you treat others. The standard you use in judging is the standard by which you will be judged. 3 "And why worry about a speck in your friend's eye when you have a log in your own?"

Luke 6:37 (CEV)

Jesus said: **Don't judge others, and God won't judge you.** Don't be hard on others, and God won't be hard on you. Forgive others, and God will forgive you.

John 7:24 (AMP)

Be honest in your judgment and do not decide at a glance (superficially and by appearances); but judge fairly and righteously.

John 7:24 (NLT)

Look beneath the surface so you can judge correctly.

Our lives are an open book test. When tests come, God has gifted us with His Word and His Spirit to reveal answers.

Matthew 13:10-15 (The Message, MSG)

10 The disciples came up and asked, "Why do you tell stories?" 11-15 He replied, "**You've been given insight into God's kingdom.** You know how it works. **Not everybody has this gift, this insight;** it hasn't been given to them. **Whenever someone has a ready heart for this, the insights and understandings flow freely.** But if there is no readiness, any trace of receptivity soon disappears. That's why I tell stories: to create readiness, to nudge the people toward receptive insight. In their present state they can stare till doomsday and not see it, listen till they're blue in the face and not get it. I don't want Isaiah's forecast repeated all over again: Your ears are open but you don't hear a thing. Your eyes are awake but you don't see a thing. The people are blockheads! They stick their fingers in their ears so they won't have to listen; They screw their eyes shut so they won't have to look, so they won't have to deal with me face-to-face and let me heal them.

Sense will never make faith...and faith (initially) will never make sense.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (New International Version, NIV)

For we live by faith, not by sight.

Prayers get answered as we maintain serving.

- **The secret to your answers is hidden in your daily routine.**
- **Serve as you would want to be served!**

Galatians 6:9 (CEV)

Don't get tired of helping others. You will be rewarded when the time is right, if you don't give up.

Success is not measured on how many people we get...It is measured on how many people we get to grow in Christ.

Timothy 4:2-5 (NLT)

2 Preach the word of God. Be prepared, whether the time is favorable or not. Patiently correct, rebuke, and encourage your people with good teaching. **3 For a time is coming when people will no longer listen to sound and wholesome teaching. They will follow their own desires and**

will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. 4 They will reject the truth and chase after myths. 5 But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you.

Honor must become a seed before it becomes a harvest.

1 Peter 3:7 (AMP)

In the same way you married men should live considerately with [your wives], with an intelligent recognition [of the marriage relation], honoring the woman as [physically] the weaker, but [realizing that you] are joint heirs of the grace (God's unmerited favor) of life, in order that your prayers may not be hindered and cut off. [Otherwise you cannot pray effectively.]

1 Peter 2:17 (New Life Version, NLV)

Show honor (respect) to all men. Love the Christians. Honor God with love and fear. Honor (respect) the head leader of the country.

1 Timothy 5:17 (AMP)

Let the elders who perform the duties of their office well be considered doubly worthy of honor [and of adequate financial support], especially those who labor faithfully in preaching and teaching.

Problems (recognized) forces you to discover new levels of excellence.

- **Inventions are the results of perceived problems.**
- **You only be remembered for two things in life: The problems you solve or the problems you create.**

Learning to Love with God's Love

Romans 5:5 (NLT)

And this hope will not lead to disappointment. **For we know how dearly God loves us, because He has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with His love.**

1 John 4:17 (NLT)

And as we live in God, our love grows more perfect. So we will not be afraid on the day of judgment, but we can face him with confidence because we live like Jesus here in this world.

1 John 2:5 (Common English Bible, CEB)

But **the love of God is truly perfected in whoever keeps his word.** This is how we know we are in him.

With God All Things Are Possible

- **We are all here today because God spoke and we listened. Will you obey if God speaks to you? If you do what seems impossible will become possible in Christ.**

Matthew 19:26 (New King James Version, NKJV)

But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."
