### **It's A Choice: Recognize**

#### **James 4:8 (New Living Translation, NLT)**

Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, **you sinners**; purify your hearts, **for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.**

#### **2 Corinthians 10:3-5 (New King James Version, NKJV)**

**3 For though we walk in the flesh**, we do not war according to the flesh. **4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,**

#### **Romans 7:14-25 (NLT)**

14 So the trouble is not with the law **[Word]**, for it is spiritual and good. The trouble is with me, for I am all too human, a slave to sin **[things of this world]**. 15 I don't really understand myself, for I want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do what I hate. 16 But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, **this shows that I agree that the law is good.** 17 So I am not the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it.

18 And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature **[flesh]**. **I want to do what is right, but I can't.** 19 I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway. 20 But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it.

21 I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. 22 I love God's law with all my heart. 23 **But there is another power within me that is at**

**war with my mind.** This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. 24 Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? 25 Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. So you see how it is: **In my mind** I really want to obey God's law, but because of my sinful nature I am a slave to sin.

**Galatians 5:1 (The Message, MSG)**

**Christ has set us free to live a free life.** So take your stand! Never again let **anyone** put a harness of slavery on you.

**Galatians 2:20 (NKJV)**

I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, **but Christ lives in me**; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, **who loved me and gave Himself for me.**

**Romans 8:1-11 (NKJV)**

1 *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. 3 **For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God *did* by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin:** He condemned sin in the flesh, 4 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

5 For those who live according to the flesh set their minds **[meditate]** on the things of the flesh, but those *who live* according to the Spirit, **[meditate]** the things of the Spirit. 6 For to be carnally minded *is* death, but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace. 7 Because the carnal mind *is* **enmity** against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. 8 **So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.**

9 But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if **indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you.** Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His. 10 And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. 11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

**It's A Choice: Renew**

**Psalms 51: 1, 10 (King James Version, KJV)**

1 Have Mercy on me, O God because of your unfailing love **[Humble]**  
10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and **renew a right spirit within me. [Pray]**

**2 Corinthians 4:16 (NKJV)**

Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward *man* is perishing, yet the **inward man is being renewed day by day.**

**Colossians 3:10 (Amplified Bible, AMP) [Seek]**

And have clothed yourselves with the new [spiritual self], which is **[ever in the process of being] renewed and remolded into [fuller and more perfect [knowledge upon] knowledge** after the image (the likeness) of Him Who created it.

### **Ephesians 4:17-24 (NLT) [Turn]**

17 With the Lord's authority I say this: Live no longer as the Gentiles do, for they are hopelessly confused. 18 **Their minds are full of darkness; they wander far from the life God gives because they have closed their minds and hardened their hearts against him.** 19 They have no sense of shame. They live for lustful pleasure and eagerly practice every kind of impurity.

20 But that isn't what you learned about Christ. 21 **Since you have heard about Jesus and have learned the truth that comes from him,** 22 throw off your old sinful nature and your former way of life, which is corrupted by lust and deception. 23 **Instead, let the Spirit renew your thoughts and attitudes.** 24 Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy.

### **It's A Choice: Receive**

#### **James 1:21-25 (AMP)**

21 So get rid of all uncleanness and the rampant outgrowth of wickedness, and in a humble (gentle, modest) spirit **receive and welcome the Word which implanted and rooted [in your hearts] contains the power to save your souls.** 22 But be doers of the Word [obey the message], and not merely listeners to it, betraying yourselves [into deception by reasoning contrary to the Truth].

23 For if anyone only listens to the Word without obeying it *and* being a doer of it, he is like a man who looks carefully at his [own] natural face in a mirror; 24 For he thoughtfully observes himself, and then goes off and promptly forgets what he was like. 25 But he who looks carefully into the faultless law, the [law] of liberty, and is faithful to it *and* perseveres in looking into it, being not a heedless listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he shall be blessed in his doing (his life of obedience).

### **What Must I Do...**

#### **2 Chronicles 7:14 (NLT)**

Then if my people who are called by my name will **Humble** themselves and **Pray** and **Seek** my face and **Turn** from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.
