I have a right to Reap

I have a right to Reap: Fasting

- **Fasting helps me to clear my mind and heart so I can hear and see clear toward collecting my harvest.**

Matthew 17:19-21 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

19 Then the disciples came to Jesus and asked privately, Why could we not drive it out? 20 He said to them, Because of the littleness of your faith [that is, your lack of firmly relying trust]. For truly I say to you, if you have faith [that is living] like a grain of mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, Move from here to yonder place, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you. 21 But this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.

I have a right to Reap: Faith

- **My faith helps me to believe I am blessed and not cursed. My faith helps me not to get stuck in the problem but find solutions and keep moving toward the promise. My faith helps me to endure while I stand in expectation for my harvest.**

Hebrews 11:6 (New Living Translation, NLT)

And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him.

Romans 10:17 (New King James Version, NKJV)

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:8 (NKJV)

But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach)

I have a right to Reap: Favor

- **My favor is God's (warning system) gift to me so I don't have to reap the sins that I sowed. If I keep ignoring the gift then that says to God I want to be on my own.**

Ephesians 2:8 (AMP)

For it is by free grace (God's unmerited favor) that you are saved (delivered from judgment and made partakers of Christ's salvation) through [your] faith. And this [salvation] is not of yourselves [of your own doing, it came not through your own striving], but it is the gift of God;

I have a right to Reap: Future

- **I am secure! Even though I might be experiencing some hardships; understanding that my seed sowed by faith in favor secures my future.**

Galatians 6:9 New Living Translation (NLT)

So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

Jeremiah 29:11 Amplified Bible (AMP)

For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, **to give you hope in your final outcome.**

I have a right to Reap so prepare for an opportunity to sow

2 Corinthians 9:10 (AMP)

And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating **will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing** and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].
