What do you do after you Sow? Recognize your Sin

- **Sin you cannot see becomes fuel for unhealthy habits, apostasy, and eventually eternal separation from God.**
- **Sin kills your seed but God's grace you receive keeps it alive.**

Psalm 119:11 (New Living Translation, NLT)

11 I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.

What do you do after you Sow? Become a serious Student

What do you do after you Sow? Review your Stewardship

➤ The principle of:

- **Ownership** - Psalm 24:1 (New International Version, NIV): 1 The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;
- **Responsibility** - Although God gives us "all things richly to enjoy," nothing is ours. Nothing really belongs to us. God owns everything; we're responsible for how we treat it and what we do with it. While we complain about our rights here on earth, the bible constantly asks, what about your responsibilities? Owners have rights; stewards have responsibilities. We are called as God's stewards to manage that which belongs to God. While God has graciously entrusted us with the care, development, and enjoyment of everything He owns as His stewards, we are responsible to manage His holdings well and according to His desires and purposes.
- **Accountability** - A steward is one who manages the possessions of another. We are all stewards of resources, abilities, and opportunities that God has entrusted to our care, and one day each of us will be called to give an account for how we have managed what the Master has given us. Last week we viewed this concept in Matthew 25:14-30 as we discussed the parable of the talents.
- **Reward** - The Word of God shows us in the parables of the Kingdom that faithful stewards who obey the master's will with the Master's resources can expect to be rewarded incompletely in this life, but fully in the next. Matthew 25:21

What do you do after you Sow? Look for your Sample of seed

Matthew 25:14-18 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

14 For it is like a man who was about to take a long journey, and he called his servants together and entrusted them with his property. 15 To one he gave five talents [probably about \$5,000], to another two, to another one—to each in proportion to his own personal ability. Then he departed and left the country. 16 He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them, and he gained five talents more. 17 And likewise he who had received the two talents—he also gained two talents more. 18 But he who had received the one talent went and dug a hole in the ground and hid his master's money.

What do you do after you Sow? Expect Steady income of seed to sow

2 Corinthians 9:10 (AMP)

10 And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].

What do you do after you Sow? Enjoy Stability of living by faith

2 Corinthians 9:8 (AMP)

8 And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation

Matthew 25:23 (AMP)

23 His master said to him, Well done, you upright (honorable, admirable) and faithful servant! You have been faithful and trustworthy over a little; I will put you in charge of much. Enter into and share the joy (the delight, the blessedness) which your master enjoys.
