### **The Gift – Adoration of the Gift Giver – Power in Praise**

- **How do I worship?**

#### **Romans 12:1-2 (Amplified Bible, AMP)**

**1 I appeal to you therefore, brethren, and beg of you in view of [all] the mercies of God, to make a decisive dedication of your bodies [presenting all your members and faculties] as a living sacrifice, holy (devoted, consecrated) and well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable (rational, intelligent) service and spiritual worship. 2 Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].**

#### **Psalm 95:1-7 (New Living Translation, NLT)**

**1 Come, let us sing to the Lord! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. 2 Let us come to him with thanksgiving. Let us sing psalms of praise to him. 3 For the Lord is a great God, a great King above all gods. 4 He holds in his hands the depths of the earth and the mightiest**

mountains. 5 The sea belongs to him, for he made it. His hands formed the dry land, too. 6 Come, **let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the Lord our maker,** 7 for he is our God. We are the people he watches over, the flock under his care. If only you would listen to his voice today!

### **Psalm 63:1-8 (New King James Version, NKJV)**

1 O God, You are my God; **Early will I seek You;** My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water. 2 **So I have looked for You in the sanctuary,** To see Your power and Your glory. 3 Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, **My lips shall praise You.** 4 Thus I will bless You while I live; **I will lift up my hands in Your name.** 5 **My soul shall be satisfied** as with marrow and fatness, **And my mouth shall praise You with joyful lips.** 6 **When I remember You on my bed, I meditate on You in the night watches.** 7 Because You have been my help, Therefore in the shadow of Your wings **I will rejoice.** 8 My soul follows close behind You; Your right hand upholds me.

### **Psalm 27:1-8 (NKJV)**

1 The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid? 2 When the wicked came against me To eat up my flesh, My enemies and foes, They stumbled and fell. 3 Though an army may encamp against me, My heart shall not fear; Though war may rise against me, In this I will be confident. 4 One thing I have desired of the Lord, That will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord All the days of my life, To behold the beauty of the Lord, And to inquire in His temple. 5 For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. 6 And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; Therefore I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord. 7 Hear, O Lord, when I cry with my voice! Have mercy also upon me, and answer me. 8 When You said, "Seek My face," My heart said to You, "Your face, Lord, I will seek."

### ➤ **How do I Worship if I feel I am not right with God?**

### **Psalm 51:1-15 (NLT)**

1 Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins. 2 Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin. 3 For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night. 4 Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just. 5 For I was born a sinner— yes, from the moment my mother conceived me. 6 But you desire honesty from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there. 7 Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. 8 Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me— now let me rejoice. 9 Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt. 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. 11 Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. 12 Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you. 13 Then I will teach your ways to rebels, and they will return to you. 14 Forgive me for shedding blood, O God who saves; then I will joyfully sing of your forgiveness. 15 Unseal my lips, O Lord, that my mouth may praise you.

➤ **Why do I Worship?**

**Psalm 40:1-5 (AMP)**

1 I waited patiently and expectantly for the Lord; and He inclined to me and heard my cry. 2 **He drew me up out of a horrible pit [a pit of tumult and of destruction], out of the miry clay (froth and slime), and set my feet upon a rock, steadying my steps and establishing my goings.** 3 **And He has put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many shall see and fear (revere and worship) and put their trust and confident reliance in the Lord.** 4 Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the man who makes the Lord his refuge and trust, and turns not to the proud or to followers of false gods. 5 Many, O Lord my God, are the wonderful works which You have done, and Your thoughts toward us; no one can compare with You! If I should declare and speak of them, they are too many to be numbered.

**Deuteronomy 8:18 (AMP)**

18 But you shall [earnestly] remember the Lord your God, for it is **He** Who **gives you power** to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

**Matthew 28:18 (King James Version, KJV)**

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

**2 Timothy 1:7 (KJV)**

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

**1 Corinthians 2:5 (NKJV)**
