My purpose is to solve problems.

- **Problems try to take your:**
 - **Commitment: Barnabas to Paul, Judas to Jesus**
 - **Confidence**
 - **Celebration**
 - **Core Values: The three Hebrew boys**

- **Problems teach you:**
 - **To be a Thinker**
 - **To be Thorough (1 Chronicles Ch. 13-16)**
 - **To be Thankful**

- **Problems cause us to review:**
 - **Structure**

Luke 6:48-49 (The Message, MSG)

48-49 "If you work the words into your life, you are like a smart carpenter who dug deep and laid the foundation of his house on bedrock. When the river burst its banks and crashed against the house, nothing could shake it; it was built to last. But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don't work them into your life, you are like a dumb carpenter who built a house but skipped the foundation. When the swollen river came crashing in, it collapsed like a house of cards. It was a total loss."

- **Jesus' problem was He was willing to take our problems.**

Luke 22:39-46 (New Living Translation, NLT)

39 Then, accompanied by the disciples, Jesus left the upstairs room and went as usual to the Mount of Olives. 40 There he told them, "Pray that you will not give in to temptation." 41 He walked away, about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, 42 "Father, if you are willing, please take this cup of suffering away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine." 43 Then an angel from heaven appeared and strengthened him. 44 He prayed more fervently, and he was in such agony of spirit that his sweat fell to the ground like great drops of blood. 45 At last he stood up again and returned to the disciples, only to find them asleep, exhausted from grief. 46 "Why are you sleeping?" he asked them. "Get up and pray, so that you will not give in to temptation."
