It's not too late: God's Ability

- **God recognizes your ability; and wants you to recognize your ability also. The space between your ability and action in His ability is faith.**

1 Corinthians 10:13 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

For no temptation (no trial regarded as enticing to sin), [no matter how it comes or where it leads] has overtaken you and laid hold on you that is not common to man [that is, no temptation or trial has come to you that is beyond human resistance and that is not adjusted and adapted and belonging to human experience, and such as man can bear]. But **God is faithful [to His Word and to His compassionate nature], and He [can be trusted] not to let you be tempted and tried and assayed beyond your ability** and strength of resistance and power to endure, but with the temptation He will [always] also provide the way out (the means of escape to a landing place), that you may be capable and strong and powerful to bear up under it patiently.

It's not too late: God's Ability

- **The more we focus on the Promises of God and follow the Instructions, we will grow to be convinced or have faith that God is able, which will yield God-type results.**

Romans 4:21 (New English Translation, NET Bible)

He was fully convinced that what God promised he was also able to do.

It's not too late: God's Ability

➤ **God Gives us Ability!**

Deuteronomy 8:18 (NET Bible)

You must remember the Lord your God, for **He is the one who gives ability** to get wealth; if you do this he will confirm his covenant that he made by oath to your ancestors, even as he has to this day.

➤ **God's ability is at work in us!**

Ephesians 3:20 (New Living Translation, NLT)

Now all glory to **God, who is able**, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think.

It's not too late: God's Ability

➤ **We stop God's ability in our lives with fear, doubt, unbelief, and (willful) ignorance.**

Ephesians 4:30-32 (The Message, MSG)

30 **Don't grieve God. Don't break his heart. His Holy Spirit, moving and breathing in you, is the most intimate part of your life, making you fit for himself. Don't take such a gift for granted.** 31-32 Make a clean break with all cutting, backbiting, profane talk. Be gentle with one another, sensitive. Forgive one another as quickly and thoroughly as God in Christ forgave you.

Ephesians 4:30-31 (Living Bible, TLB)

30 **Don't cause the Holy Spirit sorrow by the way you live.** Remember, he is the one who marks you to be present on that day when salvation from sin will be complete. 31 Stop being mean, bad-tempered, and angry.

It's not too late: God's Ability

➤ **God is Able to make all!**

2 Corinthians 9:8 (AMP)

And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

2 Corinthians 9:8 (NET Bible)

And God is able to make all grace overflow to you so that because you have enough of everything in every way at all times, you will overflow in every good work.

It's not too late: God's Ability

- **When it looks like it is too late please know with God it is never too late!**
- **The enemy is constantly trying to make us fear through the expiration of time.**
- **God's ability in you starts after your natural ability expires.**

Daniel 3:17-18 (NLT)

17 If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God whom we serve is able to save us. He will rescue us from your power, Your Majesty. 18 But even if he doesn't, we want to make it clear to you, Your Majesty, that we will never serve your gods or worship the gold statue you have set up."
