Holy Spirit

- **What is the importance of God's Spirit (Holy Spirit)...He is Father's agent in creation.**
 - **Agent: a person that acts or has the power to act (on another's behalf)**
- **Our power source is Holy Spirit**

What does being filled with Holy Spirit mean?

- **It simply means you receive the Gift of God's Spirit to live on the inside of you...it is not an emotion, it's not a feeling...it's an accepting, a receiving.**

Job 33:4 (Amplified Bible, AMP)

[It is] the Spirit of God that made me [which has stirred me up], and the breath of the Almighty that gives me life [which inspires me].

What does it mean to be filled? (I can see (perceive) things others cannot.)

John 14:15-17 (AMP)

15 If you [really] love Me, you will keep (obey) My commands. 16 And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, and Standby), that He may remain with you forever— 17 **The Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive (welcome, take to its heart), because it does not see Him or know and recognize Him. But you know and recognize Him, for He lives with you [constantly] and will be in you.**

What's the importance of Holy Spirit? (I have benefits others don't have.)

Acts 1:4-5, 8 (AMP)

4 And while being in their company and eating with them, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem but to **wait for what the Father had promised**, Of which [He said] you have heard Me speak. 5 For John baptized with water, but not many days from now **you shall be baptized with (placed in, introduced into) the Holy Spirit.**

8 But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth.

What is the importance of Holy Spirit? (I do not have to do...on my own.)

Romans 8:1-5 (AMP)

1 Therefore, [there is] now no condemnation (no adjudging guilty of wrong) for those who are in Christ Jesus, who live [and] walk not after the dictates of the flesh, but after the dictates of the Spirit.

2 For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Jesus [the law of our new being] has freed me from the law of sin and of death. 3 For God has done what the Law could not do, [its power] being weakened by the flesh the entire nature of man without the Holy Spirit]. Sending His own Son in the guise of sinful flesh and as an offering for sin, [God] condemned sin in the flesh]subdued, overcame, deprived it of its power over all who accept that sacrifice],

4 So that the righteous and just requirement of the Law might be fully met in us who live and move not in the ways of the flesh but in the ways of the Spirit [our lives governed not by the standards and according to the dictates of the flesh, but controlled by the Holy Spirit]. 5 For those who are according to the flesh and are controlled by its unholy desires set their minds on and pursue those things which gratify the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit and are controlled by the desires of the Spirit set their minds on and seek those things which gratify the [Holy] Spirit.

Romans 8:9 (AMP)

9 But you are not living the life of the flesh, you are living the life of the Spirit, if the [Holy] Spirit of God [really] dwells within you [directs and controls you]. But if anyone does not possess the [Holy] Spirit of Christ, he is none of His [he does not belong to Christ, is not truly a child of God].

Romans 8:14-16 (AMP)

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. 15 **For [the Spirit which] you have now received [is] not a spirit of slavery to put you once more in bondage to fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption [the Spirit producing sonship] in [the bliss of] which we cry, Abba (Father)! Father!** 16 **The Spirit Himself [thus] testifies together with our own spirit, [assuring us] that we are children of God.**

What is the importance of Holy Spirit? (I'm never alone.)

1 Corinthians 3:16 (New King James Version, NKJV)

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

1 Corinthians 6:19 (NKJV)

Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?

1 Corinthians 2:12 (AMP)

Now we have not received the spirit [that belongs to] the world, **but the [Holy] Spirit Who is from God, [given to us] that we might realize and comprehend and appreciate the gifts [of divine favor and blessing so freely and lavishly] bestowed on us by God.**

What is the importance of Holy Spirit: He is an Agent that lives in me to give me power.

Why should I be filled with Holy Spirit

➤ He is the Light

John 3:19 (New Living Translation, NLT)

And the judgment is based on this fact: God's light came into the world, **but people loved the darkness more than the light, for their actions were evil.**

John 1:5 (NLT)

This is the message we heard from Jesus and now declare to you: **God is light, and there is no darkness in him at all.**

John 1:4, 9 (NKJV)

4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world.

Why should I be filled with Holy Spirit

➤ He is my Helper...He gives assistance

John 14:16-17 (NKJV)

16 And I will pray the Father, and **He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever**— 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

Why should I be filled with Holy Spirit

➤ He Counsels and Convicts me

John 16:7-10 (NKJV)

7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; **for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you;** but if I depart, I will send Him to you. **8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 of sin, because they do not believe in Me; 10 of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more;**

1 Corinthians 4:4-5 (NLT)

4 My conscience is clear, but that doesn't prove I'm right. **It is the Lord himself who will examine me and decide.** 5 So don't make judgments about anyone ahead of time—before the Lord returns. **For he will bring our darkest secrets to light and will reveal our private motives.** Then God will give to each one whatever praise is due.

Why should I be filled with Holy Spirit

➤ **I have freedom**

John 8:31-32 (NKJV)

31 Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. 32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

2 Corinthians 3:17 (AMP)

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty (emancipation from bondage, freedom).
