The PURPOSE of Prayer

What is prayer?

- **Prayer is man giving God the legal right and permission to interfere in earth's affairs.**
- **Prayer is man giving heaven earthly license to influence earth.**
- **Prayer is a terrestrial license for celestial interference.**
- **Prayer is man exercising his legal authority on earth to invoke heaven's influence on the planet.**
- **Prayer is not an option for mankind, but a necessity.**

2 Chronicles 7:14, Luke 18:1-2, Ephesians 6:17-18, I Thessalonians 5:16-19, Matthew 16:19-20, Matthew 18:18-20

True prayer will do the following:

- **Build intimacy with God**
- **Bring honor to His nature and character**
- **Cause respect for His integrity**
- **Enable belief in His Word**
- **Cause a trust in His love**
- **Affirm His purposes and will**
- **Appropriate His promises**

Self-Reflection: Have I experienced unanswered prayer? How has that made me feel about prayer, about God, and about myself?

The PRACTICE of Prayer

Practice: To carry or perform out (a particular activity or method) habitually or regularly.

Lessons from the life of Daniel who Practiced Payer – Daniel 6

- **Prayer doesn't stop in opposition or for any reason. In fact it gets stronger in opposition. Vs10**
- **Prayer is bold. (he opened his Windows) vs 10**
- **Thanksgiving is vital to prayer.**
- **Prayer changes the outcomes in the earth. It supersedes norms, laws, science, schemes of the enemy etc. vs 17, 22**
- **Relationship + prayer = deliverance vs 22**
- **Consistent prayer (in line with the word and will of God) builds a reputation of victory for you and God. vs 20, 22**
- **Consistent prayer allows God's power to be seen and always points to Him. vs 21, vs 26-27**
- **Practicing prayer brings you to believe God, even in the impossible vs 23 amplified.**
- **Prayer takes care of your enemies. vs 24**
- **Prayer can bring elevation and prosperity. vs 28**

Types of Prayer

1. Praise & Thanksgiving

- **Praise and thanksgiving give adoration and worship to God.**
Psalm 150:1-6, Psalm 100:1-5, 50:23, 1 Thess 5:16-18, Hebrews 13:15

2. Confession & Repentance

- **Confession is how we receive God's forgiveness and maintain a Spirit-filled life. It is also the prerequisite for repentance.**
- **Repentance is a change of mind, heart, purpose, and life.**
Psalm 66:18, 139:23-24, 24:3-5, 51:6-10, Proverbs 28:13, 1 John 1:9

3. Petition/Supplication

- **Petition is a type of prayer in which we present our needs and desires to God.**
John 15:7, Philippians 4:6-7, Hebrews 4:15-16, 1 Peter 5:7

4. Intercession/Warfare

- **Intercession is the type of prayer that focuses on the needs of others.**
Ephesians 6:10-17, Ezekiel 22:30, 2 Corinthians 10:3-5, 1 Timothy 2:

The PROMISE (hope, expectation, assurance) of Prayer

Foundational scripture: 2 Peter 1:1-4

Simon Peter, a bond-servant and apostle (special messenger, personally chosen representative) of Jesus Christ,

To those who have received *and* possess [by God's will] a precious faith of the same kind as ours, by the righteousness of our God and Savior, Jesus Christ: ² Grace and peace [that special sense of spiritual well-being] be multiplied to you in the [true, intimate] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. ³ For His divine power has bestowed on us [absolutely] everything necessary for [a dynamic spiritual] life and godliness, through true *and* personal knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. ⁴ For by these He has bestowed on us His precious and magnificent promises [of inexpressible value], so that by them you may escape from the immoral freedom that is in the world because of disreputable desire, and become sharers of the divine nature.

- ***The hope, expectation, and assurance of prayer begins with a relationship that draws us to The Word, which becomes our very prayer.***
- ***There is no such thing as unanswered prayer!!!***
- ***The precious and magnificent promises that God has bestowed (given, committed) to us, allow us to be sharers of the divine (power of God) nature (to bring forth).***

The POWER of Prayer

Power defined

- **Strong's Concordance: *dunamis*, (miraculous power, might, strength)**
- **HELPS Word-studies: 1411 *dýnamis* "ability to perform" (L-M); for the believer, *power* to achieve by applying the Lord's *inherent abilities*. "Power through God's ability" (1411 /*dýnamis*) is needed in every scene of life to really grow in sanctification and prepare for heaven (glorification).**

Consider the following:

- **The Lord God Almighty can do all things; there is nothing impossible for Him (Luke 1:37).**
- **The Lord God Almighty invites His people to pray to Him. Prayer to God should be made persistently (Luke 18:1), with thanksgiving (Philippians 4:6), in faith (James 1:5), within the will of God (Matthew 6:10), for the glory of God (John 14:13-14), and from a heart right with God (James 5:16).**
- **The Lord God Almighty hears the prayers of His children. (Psalm 18:6)**
- **The Lord God Almighty answers prayer. (Psalm 17:6, 34:17-18)**

Heavenly Father,

You have said, “Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know” (Jer. 33:3). On the basis of this promise, we call to You and ask You to show us great and unsearchable truths about prayer that You have set forth in Your Word. Forgive us for leaning on our own understanding when it comes to prayer. Heal us from the spiritual and emotional effects of not yet seeing the answers to the prayers that we have prayed. Give us open minds and hearts to hear Your Word and to allow the Holy Spirit to teach us Your purposes and truth. We pray this in the name of Jesus, our Wisdom and our Strength. Amen!

Thankfulness is a prominent Bible theme.

First Thessalonians 5:16-18 says, "Be joyful always; pray continually; give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." Did you catch that? Give thanks in all circumstances. Thankfulness should be a way of life for us, naturally flowing from our hearts and mouths.

Definitions

Praise: to say or write good things about (someone or something): to express approval of (someone or something): to express thanks to or love and respect for (God)

- **Greek (Doxa):** Short Definition: honor, renown, glory splendor
- Definition: honor, renown; glory, an especially divine quality, the unspoken manifestation of God, splendor.
- **Hebrew (Yadah):** Thanks; giving thanks (verb)

Worship: noun 1. the feeling or expression of reverence and adoration for a deity "the worship of God"

synonyms:

- reverence, veneration, adoration, glorification, glory, exaltation;
- devotion, praise, thanksgiving, homage, honor;
- Greek: (Verb) Proskuneo (pros-koo-neh-o)

Thanksgiving: noun 1. The expression of gratitude, especially to God. "he offered prayers in thanksgiving for his safe arrival"

Gratitude: The quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness. "she expressed her gratitude to the committee for their support"

synonyms: gratefulness, thankfulness, thanks, appreciation, indebtedness; recognition, acknowledgment, credit

"Chip was miffed by his nephew's lack of gratitude"

- **The Hebrew term for gratitude** is hakarat hatov, which means, literally, "recognizing the good." Practicing gratitude means recognizing the good that is already...
