## **'In God We Trust' I trust HIM with my life!**

Sermon Notes from April 17, 2016

### **I trust HIM with my life!**

- **Unfortunately the Church is not as strong and effective as it should be in most parts of America and the World because of one main fact...People want God to fit into their way of living instead of living to change into the way of Christ. When we build religion without Christ centered relationship we disconnect the power, delete the purpose, and create demonic praise.**
- **Too often we attempt to accept our forgiveness without forgiving, our healing while hurting others, our increase without giving as God commands, our positions without revelation, our savior without repentance.**
- **For the church to become as it was designed to be we must STOP giving God a portion of our lives forcing us to live beneath the call of God on our lives and the vision we have for ourselves. We all must trust God with our whole life so our life can be whole; which means we all must surrender EVERYTHING!**

### **Matthew 4:18-22 (Amplified Bible, AMP)**

18 As Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, He noticed two brothers, Simon who was called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea; for they were fishermen. 19 And He said to them, "Follow Me [as My disciples, accepting Me as your Master and Teacher and walking the same path of life that I walk], and I will make you fishers of men." 20 **Immediately they left their nets and followed Him [becoming His disciples, believing and trusting in Him and following His example].** 21 And going on [further] from there He noticed two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee, and his brother John, in the boat with their father Zebedee, mending their nets; and He

called them [to follow Him as His disciples]. 22 **Immediately they left the boat and their father, and followed Him [becoming His disciples, believing and trusting in Him and following His example].**

### **Luke 5:27-32 (AMP)**

27 After this Jesus went out and noticed a tax collector named Levi (Matthew) sitting at the tax booth; and He said to him, “**Follow Me [as My disciple, accepting Me as your Master and Teacher and walking the same path of life that I walk].**” 28 **And he left everything behind and got up and *began* to follow Jesus [as His disciple].** 29 Levi (Matthew) gave a great banquet for Him at his house; and there was a large crowd of tax collectors and others who were reclining *at the table* with them. 30 The Pharisees and their scribes [seeing those with whom He was associating] *began* murmuring in discontent to His disciples, asking, “Why are you eating and drinking with the tax collectors and sinners [including non-observant Jews]?” 31 And Jesus replied to them, “It is not those who are healthy who need a physician, but [only] those who are sick. 32 I did not come to call the [self-proclaimed] righteous [who see no need to repent], but sinners to repentance [to change their old way of thinking, to turn from sin and to seek God and His righteousness].”

### **What is in your life that you treasure more than God?**

### **Mark 10:17-22 (AMP)**

17 As He was leaving on His journey, a man ran up and knelt before Him and asked Him, “Good Teacher [You who are essentially good and morally perfect], what shall I do to inherit eternal life [that is, eternal salvation in the Messiah’s kingdom]?” 18 Jesus said to him, “Why do you call Me good? No one is [essentially] good [by nature] except God alone. 19 You know the commandments: ‘Do not murder, Do not commit adultery, Do not steal, Do not testify falsely, Do not defraud, Honor your father and mother.’” 20 And he replied to Him, “Teacher, I have [carefully] kept all these [commandments] since my youth.” 21 **Looking at him, Jesus felt a love (high regard, compassion) for him, and He said to him, “You lack one thing: go and sell all your property and give [the money] to the poor, and you will have [abundant] treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me [becoming My disciple, believing and trusting in Me and walking the same path of life that I walk].**” 22 But the man was saddened at Jesus’ words, and he left grieving, because he owned much property *and* had many possessions [which he treasured more than his relationship with God].

### **➤ Genesis 22**

### **When I surrender ALL God says I can expect....**

### **Mark 10:23-30 (AMP)**

23 Jesus looked around and said to His disciples, “How difficult it will be for those who are wealthy [and cling to possessions and status as security] to enter the kingdom of God!” 24 The disciples were amazed *and* bewildered by His words. But Jesus said to them again, “Children, how difficult it is [for those who place their hope and confidence in riches] to enter the kingdom of God! 25 It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man [who places his faith in wealth or status] to enter the kingdom of God.” 26 They were completely *and* utterly astonished, and said to Him, “Then who can be saved [from the wrath of God]?” 27 Looking at them, Jesus said, “With people [as far as it depends on them] it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are

possible with God.” 28 **Peter started saying to Him, “Look, we have given up everything and followed You [becoming Your disciples and accepting You as Teacher and Lord].”** 29 Jesus said, “I assure you *and most solemnly say to you, there is no one who has given up a house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or farms, for My sake and for the gospel’s sake,* 30 *who will not receive a **hundred times as much now in the present age—houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and farms—along with persecutions;*** and in the age to come, eternal life.
